The WSAs (and "ISAs") in the monuments *on BLM land* are all under FLPMA Section 603 (meaning they are subject to the non impairment standard in that section of FLPMA unless and until Congress "releases" them). Note this doesn't include the Forest Service lands in Bears Ears, which has at least one designated Wilderness area and one WSA. Let me know if you need more info on the FS lands (or anything else).

**Grand Staircase Escalante NM**

The monument contains 16 WSAs and ISAs totaling approximately 882K acres, which were created under FLPMA Section 603. They include the following:
