Hey Ben,

Attached (also saved in the Monuments Review folder) is a spreadsheet of the acreages from BLM/Nikki compared to the acreages in the individual data call documents (typically taken from the Executive Summary on each monument). In many cases they are small or likely due to rounding but there are a few cases where the differences appear to be due to the inclusion of inholdings in the data call information. I have highlighted the cases that look suspect. There are also a couple that I had specific questions on that I included in the spreadsheet. I think we just want to confirm whether we should be using the data that Nikki just sent and then make sure we are consistent with using that across the reviews.
