VI. Weekly Report:

Week Ahead Announcements and Actions

On October 23 - 25, BLM-CO Royal Gorge Field Office, CO Parks and Wildlife and the U.S. Forest Service will hold three public meetings to discuss plans to revise the Arkansas Headwaters Recreation Area River Management Plan. Discussion will focus on current boating capacities and existing facilities along the Arkansas River, from Leadville to Lake Pueblo State Park. The meetings will be held in Colorado Springs, Cañon City, and Buena Vista.

On October 23 - 24, the Sage Grouse Task Force is scheduled to meet in Denver to discuss any additional issues or concerns raised by stakeholders, specific proposed policy changes, and any remaining issues that may require a plan amendment in connection with Secretarial Order 3353. The task is led by the governors of WY and CO, and includes membership from the 11 sage-grouse states, the BLM, U.S. Forest Service, Natural Resources Conservation Service, United States Geological Survey, and the Fish & Wildlife Service.

On October 24, BLM-NV will host a competitive geothermal lease sale for 20 parcels, located in the Battle Mountain, Carson City, Elko and Winnemucca districts, containing 38,208.46 acres for geothermal leasing. This will be the first online geothermal lease sale for Nevada. This lease sale is not expected to be controversial. At this time, the BLM cannot predict the level of bidding interest.

On October 24, BLM-WY Worland Field Office will host a public meeting in Hyattville, Wyoming, in support of the 30-day scoping period for the Alkali Creek Reservoir Project Environmental Impact Statement. The State of Wyoming Water Development Commission proposes to construct a 294-acre reservoir and ancillary facilities across public land managed by the Worland Field Office. The project is intended to support multiple uses by providing for late season irrigation, flood attenuation and recreation. Cooperating agencies include the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, State of Wyoming, Big Horn County Commission and South Big Horn Conservation District. Local media may attend.

On October 24, BLM-WY Cody Field Office will host public meetings in Cody and Lovell, Wyoming, to gather input for a cave and karst management plan that will address the natural, undisturbed ecosystems within caves, recreational caving, scientific research and surface uses above caves. Local media may attend.

On October 24, BLM-CA State Director Jerry Perez and Desert District Manager Beth Ransel will meet with Brigadier General Kevin Killea, Commanding General, Marine Corps Installations West, at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton. Meeting topics will include implementation of base expansion and land transfer, renewable energy, desert tortoises, recreation and off-highway vehicle access.

On October 25, BLM-CA State Director Jerry Perez, Desert District Manager Beth Ransel and Barstow Field Manager Katrina Symons will meet with officials at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms and Chocolate Mountain Aerial Gunnery Range. Issues to be discussed include implementation of base expansion and land transfer, renewable energy, desert tortoises, recreation and off-highway vehicle access.

On October 26, BLM-AK Acting State Director Karen Mouritsen will attend the Alaska Mapping Executive Committee meeting at the U.S. Geological Survey Alaska Science Center, in Anchorage. The BLM plays a critical role in the Alaska Mapping Initiative.

On October 26, BLM-WY Cody Field Office will host a public meeting in Shell, Wyoming, in support of the 45-day scoping period for the Leavitt Reservoir Expansion Project Environmental Impact Statement. The State of Wyoming Water Development Commission proposes to expand Leavitt Reservoir from a surface area of approximately 36 acres and a capacity of 643 acre-feet of water to 194 acres with a capacity of 6,604 acre-feet. The water project is intended to support multiple-uses by providing for late season irrigation, flood attenuation and recreation. Cooperating agencies include the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, State of Wyoming, Big Horn County Commission and South Big Horn Conservation District. Local media may attend.

On October 26, BLM-WY Casper Field Office will hold a public meeting about tribal consultation for oil and gas permits in Converse County, Wyoming. The meeting will include a presentation and will transition to an open house format to enable the public to speak with specialists about tribal consultation and oil and gas permitting. Acting Field Manager Chris Durham; Acting Assistant Field Manager - Resources Ben Bigalke; Assistant Field Manager - Minerals and Lands Kathleen Lacko; and permitting staff and cultural staff from the Casper Field Office will be at the meeting and available to the public. The public and media are invited.

In mid-to-late fall, BLM-CO expects to issue a decision on whether to grant a royalty rate reduction for the West Elk Mine. The BLM proposes to approve Mountain Coal Company, LLC's, application for a royalty rate reduction from 8 percent to 5 percent for 10.3 million tons of coal in the West Elk Mine in southwest Colorado's North Fork Valley. Colorado Gov. John Hickenlooper expressed support for the royalty rate reduction, contingent on Mountain Coal Company exploring methane capture at the mine.

In mid- to late fall, BLM-CO expects to issue a decision on whether to modify GCC Energy's King II Mine in Montezuma County, in southwest Colorado, by 951 acres. The modification would allow the company to access an estimated 4.66 million tons of recoverable federal coal reserves for an additional 6.5 years of mining. The county supports the modification, noting federal mineral development's positive impacts on the region through jobs and tax revenue. The BLM hopes to issue the decision this fall, pending final approval from DOI.

30 - 60 Day Look-Ahead

On October 30 - November 3, BLM-UT State Director Ed Roberson will visit with members and staff of the Utah congressional delegation. Topics will focus on public land management issues in Utah.

On November 1 - 2, BLM-MT will host a tribal consultation meeting at the Montana/Dakotas State Office, in Billings, to discuss tribal issues and items of interest related to the Denbury Resources, Inc. CO2 Pipeline and Enhanced Recovery Project (in southeast Montana); the BNI Coal Ltd. expansion proposal, "BNI-2" (in western North Dakota); and various fire fuels reduction projects in eastern Montana. Tribal Council Presidents/Chairs and Tribal Historic Preservation Officers from 17 Tribes representing Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota and Wyoming are invited to the meeting. This is not a meeting where media or public have been formally invited to attend.

On November 2, Nevada Gov. Brian Sandoval will dedicate a section of Highway 140 in memory of BLM firefighters Will Hawkins and Jacob O'Malley, who died in a vehicle accident. This ceremony will be held at the memorial site, 6 miles west of the Highway 95/140 junction. Gov. Sandoval, family members of Jake and Will, and Winnemucca/State Fire Managers will speak at the ceremony.

On November 5 - 11, BLM-AK Acting State Director Karen Mouritsen and mining staff will attend portions of the Alaska Miners Association Fall Convention & Trade Show, in Anchorage. BLM-AK Energy and Minerals Branch will be involved in multiple presentations. The convention offers geophysical, geochemical and Alaska National Interest Conservation Act short courses, as well as technical and policy sessions. The agenda is available at <https://alma.memberclicks.net/2017-convention>.

On November 6, BLM Acting Director Mike Nedd will attend the National Mining Association/BLM Sustainable Development Awards in Washington, D.C. The awards are presented by the BLM in recognition of outstanding reclamation activities.

On November 13 - 15, BLM Senior Advisor Kathy Benedetto will attend the Idaho Cattle Association Annual Convention, in Sun Valley, to discuss Sage-Grouse issues, including the Sage-Grouse Secretary's Order.

On November 13 - 20, BLM will participate in public meetings hosted by the National Off-Highway Vehicle Council on behalf of the BLM national office in Nevada to discuss future opportunities for off-highway vehicle recreation on public lands. Topics will include what types of amenities communities are most interested in (rock crawling, trails, parks, trailheads, parking, etc.). Meetings are scheduled for these locations: Ely, Nov. 13; Elko, Nov. 14; Winnemucca, Nov. 15; Reno, Nov. 16; Pahrump, Nov. 17; Las Vegas, Nov. 20.

On November 16 - 17, BLM-AK Acting State Director Karen Mouritsen will attend sessions at the 38th Annual Alaska Resources Conference, in Anchorage. The conference is hosted by the Alaska Resource Development Council, a nonprofit, membership-funded organization of Alaska's oil and gas, mining, timber, tourism, and fisheries industries.

On November 17, the Nevada Association of Counties will hold its monthly board of directors meeting in Carson City. BLM-NV Chief of Communications Steve Clutter will attend.

On November 28 - 30, Office of Natural Resources Revenue Indian Allottee Outreach Meetings will be held in New Town, North Dakota. Representatives from the BLM, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Office of Natural Resources Revenue, and Office of the Special Trustee will be available to answer questions from individual Indian Mineral interest owners on mineral ownership, development and royalties. ONRR will mail a meeting notice reminder to individuals living locally and advertise in local media. This is not an event where media or public have been invited.

On December 1-2, BLM will attend the Western Governors' Association Annual Meeting in Phoenix, Arizona. A BLM representative has not yet been determined.

On December 6, BLM-AK will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 900 tracts, covering 10.3 million acres in the National Petroleum Reserve in Alaska. Currently, 189 authorized leases in the petroleum reserve cover more than 1,372,688 acres. This lease sale, the 13th in the reserve since 1999, is also the reserve's first oil and gas lease sale to occur via livestream video. This is the first time that all available tracts will be offered for lease, which is a potential source of controversy. Additional controversy is expected if BLM-AK modifies the reserve's Integrated Activity Plan prior to the sale. Bidding is expected to be moderate.

On December 7, BLM-NM will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 7 parcels, totaling 2,104 acres in Eddy and Lea counties. The sale is expected to be controversial and is likely to be protested by environmental groups concerned with the potential impacts of hydraulic fracturing on air and water quality. The bidding is expected to be robust.

On December 7, BLM-CO will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 10 parcels totaling 1,227 acres in Garfield and Mesa counties. The sale will likely be controversial due to recent media coverage regarding leasing in the Grand Junction area overlapping with potential solar sites. Bidding is expected to be robust.

On December 7, BLM Senior Advisor Kathy Benedetto will give the keynote address at the Public Lands session of the American Exploration and Mining Conference in Reno, Nevada. Topics for the speech have not yet been determined.

On December 12, BLM-NV will hold an online oil and gas sale for 208 parcels, totaling 388,959.402 acres in White Pine, Lincoln and Nye counties. This sale may be controversial. BLM-NV has received comments from the Environmental Protection Agency, Center for Biological Diversity, Great Basin Water District and Nevada Department of Wildlife. At this time, likely bidding interest is unknown.

On December 14, BLM-ES will hold an oil and gas lease sale for seven parcels, totaling 1,185 acres in Ohio and Louisiana. The sale will include five parcels, totaling 350.06 acres in the Wayne National Forest, Monroe County, Ohio; and two parcels totaling 834.70 acres in the Kisatchie National Forest, Natchitoches and Winn Parishes, Louisiana. The protest period for parcels offered in this sale concluded October 13, 2017. The parcels being offered in the Wayne National Forest are expected to be controversial. At this time, likely bidding interest is unknown.

On December 14, BLM-UT will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 75 parcels, totaling 94,000 acres in Duchesne, Uintah and Emery counties. The sale is expected to be controversial due to the nomination of parcels near Dinosaur National Monument. Two of the three parcels nominated by industry for consideration near the boundary of the Dinosaur National Monument have been deferred by BLM Utah for consultation with the National Park Service. The remaining parcel contains both BLM-managed and split estate land, and has a small portion in view of the monument. The portion of land within view of the monument is privately owned. The BLM, however, has applied stipulations for light and noise pollution, and to minimize impacts to air quality and the scenic viewshed. Bidding is expected to be robust.

On December 14, BLM-WY will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 45 parcels, totaling 72,843 acres in Laramie, Sweetwater, Uinta and Lincoln counties. The sale is not anticipated to be controversial. Bidding is not expected to be robust.
