Hi all

My only comments would have been similar to yours thus far. We might want to clarify that there are two pending waiver requests at WO now. One for SO, one for GSE. We are requesting the third for the second SO GS12. Pam will need to submit that ASAP. The rest can go in as a pkg.

One other consideration - identify where some options could be contracted (one year/multiyear \$) vs PFT/CS or term.

My only other concern is the size/complexity of the NMs in comparison to other newer NMs across BLM, and how our proposal compares. A call to Sally or Nikki might get us some detail on that, but wouldn't necessarily change our ask. Size of the monument and the need for planning is an issue elsewhere too.

Pam:

A couple of items from me, and I will defer to Harry & Matt for their additional or alternative input:

1. D. LWC Inventory Strike Team-both efforts: It will help to add a team lead/ GS 11 or 12 to this team to direct their efforts.
2. E. GSENM Staffing needs:

- I would also recommend a GS-13 for the Project Manager term position for GSENM. The level and complexity of this effort warrants the GS-13 and most of the leadership positions on GSENM are currently being filled by details.
- The Geologist is for the "Lands formerly known as GSENM" if that matters. This will be to assist with sand/gravel/oil & gas/coal applications as well as provide planning expertise or back-up for field work.
- Add a term GS-9 Paleontologist (1350) to provide back-up on field work/lab/etc as lone paleontologist will have additional planning responsibilities.
- Add a term GS-9 GIS 0301 GIS Specialist to provide back-up for planning effort.
- The additional Law Enforcement Officer would cover the Kaiparowits unit/ central part of the Monument/ Field Office.
- Add 3 Archaeology Survey Technicians- Term- to assist with the cultural survey work. 6 months of work.
- Add 3 NRS/Biologist technicians -Term- to complete critical surveys for baseline information.
