I have now encountered a second discrepancy, at Canyons of the Ancients, where our chart says 175,160 and the monument web site says "Over 176,000 Acres". To save us both time, I am attaching the overall chart. Would you please review the acreage figures for all of the BLM managed or co-managed monuments here - except Bears Ears and Vermilion Cliffs, which we checked in August - and let me know later today what the correct acreage figures are.

I had no advance notice of this exercise or would have gotten the chart to you earlier.

For Grand Staircase-Escalante – The chart in the Federal Register notice had 1,700,000.00 acres. However, your web site has 1,870,000 acres. Another figure circulating is 1,878,465 acres.
