VI. Weekly Report:

Week Ahead Schedule of Meetings, Hearings, and Travel

On Wednesday, July 5, BLM-NM Acting Rio Puerco Field Manager Angel Martinez and Assistant Field Manager for Multi Resources Calvin Parson will meet with the Governor of the Zia Pueblo Tribe at the Zia Pueblo. Among the topics they will discuss are the possibility of a local shooting range and access to the local off-highway vehicle area.

On Wednesday, July 5, BLM-NM State Director Amy Lueders and Associate State Director Aden Seidlitz will discuss the BLM Managed Public Lands Interface with the Southwest Energy Program Manager of the National Parks Conservation Association. The meeting is in the BLM NM State Office. Attending from the National Parks Conservation Association are: Jerry Otero (Southwest Energy Program Manager), Ernie Atencio (NM Program Manager) and David Nimkin (Director of the Southwest Region of NPCA)

Week Ahead Announcements and Actions

The 30-day public protest period is open through July for BLM-CA's Sonoran Desert National Monument Proposed Resource Management Plan Amendment for Recreational Target Shooting and Final Environmental Impact Statement. The comment period will close July 31.

Fire restrictions on BLM-managed lands in California, which were issued in late May (23-26 in multiple districts) remain in place throughout the state to reduce wildfire threats due to rising temperatures and fuels that are drying out. The restrictions prohibit campfires except in developed campsites and recreation areas. Some of the fire restrictions also prohibit off-road use of internal combustion engines, limit smoking to developed sites, and prohibit target shootings from using spark-producing ammunition and targets. The U.S. Forest Service have issued similar restrictions across the state.

BLM-CA anticipates that a proposed exchange, called the Hester Land Exchange, will close sometime in July. It is in escrow until funding can be secured by the Hester Granite Co. In the exchange, the BLM

will acquire approximately 550 acres of non-federal lands within the new Sand to Snow National Monument (Designated by President Obama in 2016, along with Castle Mountains NM and Mojave Trails NM) in Riverside County, in exchange for 40 acres of Federal mineral interests located on private property in San Diego County. Acquiring lands within the monument will improve management of public lands by consolidating Federal lands, enhancing public access, and improving the preservation and protection of nationally significant biological, cultural, recreational, geological, educational, and scientific values. The exchange (the process started in July 2013) finalizes restitution of a trespass settlement. California Rep. Duncan Hunter, Jr., of San Diego County, has been a strong advocate for the exchange and the BLM is keeping him informed of its progress.

BLM-CA Arcata Field Office is conducting a public protest period on a proposed amendment to the Headwaters Forest Reserve Management Plan through July 24. The amendment enables the field office to expand forest restoration activities beyond those from the original management plan completed in 2004. The BLM received few comments, which were all positive, during the public comment period on plan amendment development. The BLM and California Department of Fish and Wildlife jointly manage the 7,400-acre reserve.

From July 6 to 8, BLM-ES Director Karen Mouritsen will attend one day of the Extreme Mustang Makeover in Lexington, KY, a competition that challenges horse trainers from around the country to gentle wild horses during about 100 days of training for the chance to win cash and prizes. The competition, sponsored by the Mustang Heritage Foundation in partnership with the BLM, promotes wild horse adoptions and displays the trainability of the animals. The event is held throughout the country.

During the days leading up to and including the Fourth of July, BLM-CA will work closely with California's Kern County Sheriff's Office and the Forest Service to address an anticipated surge in visitation at the BLM Keysville Special Recreation Management Area. Keysville, an age-old mining area with a historic fort as well as other structures, offers white-water rafting, fishing, recreational gold panning, and a network of more than 70 miles of trails for mountain biking, horseback riding, and off-highway vehicle use. Visitors, who are expected to be primarily from Southern California, will help boost the local economy. By partnering with the Sheriff's Department and the Forest Service, the BLM hopes to ensure a safe holiday.

On July 3, BLM-AK will review and provide comments for the Donlin Gold preliminary Final Environmental Impact Statement for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the lead agency for the project. Donlin Gold, LLC., applied for permits for an open pit, hardrock gold mine about 10 miles north of Crooked Creek, 277 miles west of Anchorage and 145 miles northeast of Bethel, in southwest Alaska. The project also involves transportation infrastructure and a pipeline.

In early July, BLM plans to issue the Boardman to Hemingway Environmental (EIS) Record of Decision (ROD). The decision will be issued simultaneously with the approval to issue a right-of-way grant for construction of a new 500 kilovolt, single-circuit electric transmission line that will span from a proposed substation near Boardman, OR, to the Hemingway Substation near Melba, ID.

30- 60 Day Look-Ahead

On July 10, four individuals charged with various crimes during the 2014 Gold Butte cattle impoundment are scheduled to be re-tried following the declaration of a mistrial on April 24, 2017.

On July 10, BLM Natural Resource Specialist Bob Wick will participate on an interagency panel to discuss wildlife management issues in wilderness at the Western Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies (WAFWA) annual conference in Vail, CO.

On July 11, BLM Cultural and Law Enforcement program staffs will meet with Government Accountability Office (GAO) in Washington, D.C., to discuss looting and trafficking in Native American artifacts. GAO representative Casey Brown requested the meeting as part of their current focus on looting and trafficking and to follow-up on their prior review of Federal agency compliance with the Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act. BLM representatives will include Byron Loosle, Ranel Capron, and Emily Palus with the Cultural Resources Program, and Paul Mastando with BLM Law Enforcement.

On July 11, BLM-OR Upper Willamette Field Office Manager Bill O'Sullivan and fire staff will participate in the 2017 Eastern Lane Forest Protection Association Summer Tour in Springfield, OR. During the tour, participants will discuss protection across public and private industry forest lands.

On July 13, the BLM-AK's Glennallen Field Office will begin issuing permits for the 2017 to 2018 Unit 13 Federal subsistence moose and caribou hunting seasons. The BLM issues nearly 3,500 Federal subsistence permits annually and provides permitting opportunities to rural residents in Delta Junction, Cantwell, Slana, and Glennallen.

BLM –ES will hold a wild horse and burro adoption **July 14 to 15** in Annville, PA, where it will make from 20 to 60 animals available for adoption to the public. The exact number will be determined the week prior to adoption.

Dean Bolstad, BLM Division Chief of the Wild Horse and Burro Program, will participate on a panel regarding key needs and challenges regarding fertility control for wild horses and wildlife as part of the 8th International Wildlife Fertility Control conference **July 18 to 21** in Washington, D.C. The panel will include representatives from Federal and international agencies, academics and non-profit organizations. The conference is hosted by the Botstiber Institute for Wildlife Fertility Control, a partnership between The Humane Society of the United States and the Dietrich W. Botstiber Foundation.

BLM-ES, in conjunction with the Forest Service will hold public meetings in St. Paul, MN, and Virginia, MN, **July 18 and 25**, respectively, to solicit comments regarding the proposed 20-year withdrawal of Federal minerals from the Rainy River Watershed on the Superior National Forest. Dean Gettinger, Northeastern States District Manager, will attend, as will Forest Service employees Tony Erba, Regional Planning Director, and Jason Kirchner, Media and External Relations Specialist, both from the Eastern

Region. The FS is the lead agency for developing the Environmental Impact Statement; the BLM is a cooperating agency.

From July 17 to 19, BLM-CA Bakersfield Field Office resources staff will conduct bat surveys in the southern Sierra help determine how to best manage abandoned mine land projects. Information on the presence or absence of sensitive bat species could change the timing and design of future mine closures.

From July 14 to August 25, BLM-AK plans a temporary shutdown of the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System. Alyeska Pipeline Services Company plans safety and integrity protection system (also known as “SIPPS”) downloads requiring short-term shutdowns for the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System this summer. The BLM Alaska Branch of Pipeline Monitoring will observe the shutdowns.

On July 19, BLM-NM will hold an auction of Federally-owned crude helium. Under the Helium Stewardship Act of 2013, the BLM must offer for auction and sale annually a portion of the helium reserves stored underground at the Cliffside Gas Field, near Amarillo, TX. The BLM anticipates auctioning 500 MMcf in a total of 30 lots for delivery in FY 2018. Following the auction, the BLM will offer an allocated sale in which helium is offered to refiners, and a non-allocated sale in which the helium is offered to non-refiners.

On July 22, the BLM-OR/WA Lakeview Resource Area will hold an open house focused on the management of wild horses in the Beatty Butte Herd Management Area near Adel, OR, and its ongoing work with a private, non-profit partner that is developing a multi-pronged approach to managing the animals. For the first time, an external partner will work with BLM staff to bait trap horses, administer PZP to mares, and gentle horses considered good candidates for adoption.

From July 24-30, BLM-CA Bakersfield Field Office resources staff will participate in the Fresno American Indian Health Project’s Gathering of Native Americans (GONA), a 5-day program serving native youth in California. Participants are principally from Fresno and Tulare counties. The gathering has been sponsored by the Fresno American Indian Health Project since 2012; Bakersfield Field Office staff has participated every year.

On July 26, acting BLM Deputy Director for Operations John Ruhs will attend the Nevada Sheriff’s Association meeting and provide a general BLM presentation.

On July 26 and August 30, the BLM and community partners will host hikes and tours at the California Coastal National Monument at Piedras Blancas Light Station Outstanding Natural Area. Approximately 150 hikers are expected to use a portion California Coastal Trail to access the Light Station.

Through July, the U.S. Army will be working on a munitions cleanup in public access areas at CA’s Fort Ord National Monument. The cleanup encompasses about 800 acres of BLM-managed lands and Army-managed lands in the northern portion of the Monument. The first phase of cleanup is cutting vegetation, which will require road and trail closures. The second phase of the cleanup will include prescribed burning.

July 31 will be the final day of the 30-day public protest period for BLM-CA's Sonoran Desert National Monument Proposed Resource Management Plan Amendment for Recreational Target Shooting and Final Environmental Impact Statement.

On August 2, BLM staff will meet with an International Visitor Leadership Program group hosted by the University of Montana at the Main Interior Building from 9 to 11 a.m. The university has requested that Secretary Zinke greet the group. Timothy Fisher, BLM Program Management Analyst from the National Conservation Landscape Program and a to-be-determined BLM employee from BLM Minerals and Realty directorate will meet with the group.

On August 3, BLM-NV Las Vegas Field Office will hold the spring land sale under the Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act (SNPLMA) in Las Vegas. The BLM proposes to offer 81.25 acres of public land in 17 parcels for competitive sale. In accordance with SNPLMA, funds generated by this proposed sale will be used for projects such as the development of parks, trails, and natural areas, capital improvements on Federal lands, acquisition of environmentally sensitive land, and Lake Tahoe restoration projects.
