VII. Weekly Report:

Week Ahead Announcements and Actions

On August 8, BLM-AK will continue work on the Ambler Mining District Industrial Access Road Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for a proposed 211-mile controlled access road in the southern foothills of the Brooks Range. The Northwest Arctic Borough is now a cooperating agency. BLM-AK's monthly cooperating agency meeting is August 8. The public scoping period ends January 31, 2018.

On August 8, BLM-AK Associate State Director Ted Murphy will participate in a mining compliance inspection at the Constantine Mine near Haines.

On August 9-11, BLM-MT Tribal Coordinator Marcia Pablo will meet with Tribal Historic Preservation Officers and possibly the Chairmen/Presidents of 14 tribes in the three-state area in August and September. BLM already has good standing with many of the tribes, and these meetings are meant to enhance and build relationships. She will meet with the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribe in Pablo, Montana, August 9-11; the Three Affiliated Tribes (Mandan, Hidatsa, and Arikara), Standing Rock and Spirit Lake tribes in North Dakota the week of August 21; and the Rosebud, Pine Ridge, Lower Brule, Crow Creek, Cheyenne River, and Yankton tribes in South Dakota the week of September 11. Meetings will also be scheduled with the Fort Peck, Blackfeet, Crow, and Northern Cheyenne tribes in Montana.

On August 11 - 25, the United States Marine Corps (USMC) will close BLM-CA's 56,000-acre Johnson Valley Off-Highway Vehicle Shared Use Area to the public, while the USMC Air Ground Combat Center at Twenty-nine Palms conducts an annual large-scale training exercise in accordance to the National Defense Authorization Act of 2014. The adjacent 43,000-acre Recreation Area will remain open to the public during the closure of the Shared Use Area.

On August 12, BLM-NV Ely District expects to issue a Special Recreation Permit for the 2017 Silver State Trailblazers Muley Run National Hare and Hound, a motorcycle-only competitive off-road race scheduled Saturday, Aug. 12, in Caliente, Nev. The Muley Run is Round 7 of the Kenda/SRT AMA Hare & Hound National Championship Series. Between 250-300 participants and 100-200 spectators are expected.

30 - 60 Day Look-Ahead

On August 14, the public comment period for BLM-NV's Silver King Herd Management Area Preliminary Environmental Assessment closes. It analyzes the need to gather and remove excess wild horses from in and outside the Silver King HMA located in eastern Nevada. Appropriate Management Level for the HMA is 60-128 wild horses. The estimated population is 850. Under the proposed plan, the BLM could conduct an initial gather in late summer 2017 followed by maintenance gathers over a 10-year period. Mares released back into the HMA would receive fertility control treatments.

On August 14, BLM-CO White River Field Office will announce its decision approving the removal of wild horses that have moved outside the boundaries of the 190,000-acre Piceance-East Douglas Herd Management Area (HMA). The Environmental Assessment is a baseline document for potential future wild horse removals outside the HMA that could include using helicopters and/or bait- and water-trapping. It includes a proposed helicopter gather of up to 100 wild horses outside the HMA this fall. The Field Office (FO) estimates there are 217 wild horses outside the HMA within the analysis area.

On August 14-19, BLM-UT will conduct a wild horse gather in the Bible Springs Complex, located in southwest Utah. The objective of this gather is to capture and remove approximately 100 head of wild horses that are currently impacting lands managed by the State of Utah, School and Institutional Trust Lands Administration. Approximately 50 head will be captured at two different locations and then transported to the Axtell wild horse facility. The body condition of the horses is currently not an issue, but that may change as available water and/or forage decreases.

On August 15, the public comment period closes on BLM-NV's Preliminary Environmental Assessment for the Washoe County School District Sun Valley School Campus Project. The project area is located in Sun Valley, north of Reno, in Washoe County.

During the week of August 21, OMB examiners tentatively plan to visit field locations in ND and WY to observe BLM oil, coal, and wind energy activities, with special interest in the Bakken, Powder River Basin, and wind energy efforts in WY. Participants will likely include Mike Hagan and Ben Burnett (OMB), Bill Gordon (POB), and Linda Smith (BLM-WO Budget Officer).

On August 21, NV Senator Catherine Cortez Masto will tour the Indian Lakes corral, a privately owned, contracted off-range wild horse corral in Fallon, NV. Currently, 2,210 wild horses and 2 burros are housed at the facility, which has the capacity to house up to 3,200 wild horses and burros.

On August 21, Bob Wick will be working with the Communications Directorate, Idaho State Office, and Idaho Falls District to capture footage of the total solar eclipse for use on various social media platforms. The current tentative location is Jerry Peak Wilderness area. The BLM has been coordinating with DOI to have access to several platforms during the event.

On August 22, BLM-AK State Director Bud Cribley will attend the Alaska Mapping Executive Committee meeting held at the BLM-AK Campbell Creek Science Center. The committee coordinates critical mapping activities, including acquisition of key map data layers in Alaska. Executive level managers from 15 Federal agencies and the State of Alaska serve as committee members.

On August 22, Arizona Representative Martha McSally will visit the BLM Aravaipa Veteran Firefighting Crew's facility, as part of a larger tour of the U.S. Army's Fort Huachuca post in Sierra Vista, Arizona. The Army will lead the tour of the Fort while BLM AZ representatives will lead the visit to the fire station on the Fort. The BLM AZ State Director and Gila District Manager will accompany Rep. McSally to the facility. Her visit will include an overview by the State Fire Management Officer of how the crew was established, the partnership with the Fort to house them, the uniqueness of the mostly Veteran crew, and their goal of future qualification as a BLM Hot Shot crew. The crew is scheduled to meet Rep. McSally if they are not called away on a fire assignment.

On August 22-24, the State of Utah will host a National Wild Horse and Burro Management Summit in Salt Lake City. Registration for the Summit is by invitation only and the BLM has been invited to participate. The Summit will begin with a field tour of the Onaqui Herd Management Area followed by a tour of the BLM's Delta Wild Horse and Burro Facility coordinated by Utah Wild Horse and Burro Program Lead, Gus Warr.

On August 23, BLM-CA Redding Field Office staff will attend a quarterly board meeting of the Sacramento River Conservation Forum, a group that works with communities, agricultural interests, landowners and land management agencies, to facilitate effective and balanced resource management and restoration efforts along California's largest river.

On August 22 – 24, Acting ASLM Kate MacGregor and BLM Wild Horse and Burro Program staff will participate in the National Wild Horse and Burro Summit in Salt Lake City, UT. Participants will discuss science, policy, resource impacts, and management options for on- and off-range populations. Secretary

Zinke has been invited to speak. Other participants may include State partners, Members of Congress, and interest groups.

On August 24, the Final Report required under Executive Order 13792 will be submitted by Secretary Zinke to the President regarding the Antiquities Act and National Monuments. From April 2017, to present, BLM's Washington Office has been coordinating with BLM state offices, Monument Managers, and the DOI Office of Policy Analysis, and will continue to provide any requested reviews and/or additional information in support of the Final Report.

On August 27, the Burning Man event begins on the Black Rock Desert in Northern Nevada. The event, which is expected to draw up to 70,000 people, is the largest Special Recreation Permit managed by BLM. It concludes on September 4.

On August 28, the 30-day public comment period for the Egan and Johnson Basin Restoration Project Preliminary Environmental Assessment closes. The project goal is to reduce the risk of catastrophic wildfire and improve Greater Sage-grouse habitat through manual and mechanical pinion-juniper tree-thinning, invasive plant treatments and prescribed fire use. The project would treat up to 24,375 acres in 21 treatment units. The BLM would also manually thin pinion-juniper in specified areas outside the treatment units, but within the total 84,675-acre project area.

On September 6 - 7, BLM-AK State Director Bud Cribley and North Slope Science Initiative Executive Director Sara Longan and Deputy Director Mark Miller will attend the Arctic Council's Conservation of Arctic Flora and Fauna first board meeting under US Chairmanship in Bethel, Alaska. Sara Longan will be serving in her role as co-lead for the Circumpolar Biodiversity Monitoring Program, along with the Kingdom of Denmark. Also expected to attend are representatives from the Arctic Council eight member states, permanent participants representing the six indigenous people's organizations of the circumpolar north, observer states, organizations and partners.

On September 7, BLM-CO will hold an online oil and gas lease sale for 10 parcels totaling 1,227 acres in Cheyenne, Baca, Kiowa, Yuma, Morgan, and Weld Counties, CO. The sale is not particularly controversial and the bidding is not expected to be robust.

On September 7, BLM-NM will hold an online oil and gas lease sale for 62 parcels totaling 15,731 acres in Eddy, Chaves, Quay, Curry, Roosevelt, and Lea Counties, NM. The sale is not particularly controversial and the bidding is not expected to be robust.

On September 11, the BLM will unveil its new Travel and Tourism plan, currently under agency review, at the annual American Indian and Alaska Native Tourism Association's meeting in Green Bay, WI.

On September 12, BLM-NV will hold an online oil and gas lease sale for 3 parcels totaling 3,680 acres in Nye County, NV. The sale is not particularly controversial and the bidding is not expected to be robust.

On September 12, BLM-MT will hold an online oil and gas lease sale for 15 parcels totaling 4,438 acres in Juab County, UT. The sale is not particularly controversial and the bidding is not expected to be robust.

On September 12, BLM-UT will hold an online oil and gas lease sale for 9 parcels totaling 14,943 acres in Nye County, NV. The sale is not particularly controversial and the bidding is not expected to be robust.

On September 12, BLM-NV Tonopah Field Office will hold a competitive oil and gas lease sale for 3 parcels totaling 3,680 acres.

On September 18 - 21, BLM-AK State Director Bud Cribley and the BOEM-AK Region will attend the OCEANS 17 conference/exhibition, in Anchorage. The event will address the use of both modern technology and traditional knowledge to work together on issues, including the energy extraction and increased vessel traffic in Arctic waters. Sponsored by the Marine Technology Society, the IEEE Oceanic Engineering Society, and BOEM, the OCEANS conferences/exhibits draw an international audience of more than 2,000.

On September 26, BLM-AK State Director Bud Cribley (tentative), North Slope Science Initiative Executive Director Sara Longan and Deputy Director Mark Miller will attend the Arctic Council's Conservation of Arctic Flora and Fauna Working Group Alaska partners' meeting in Anchorage. Also expected to attend are representatives from the Arctic Council eight member states, permanent participants representing the six indigenous people's organizations of the circumpolar north, observer states, organizations and partners.
