Jim asked me for some material when I stopped by to check on whether USDA was invited to the Inter-Tribal Coalition meeting (not), a large map to be rolled out on the table and a list of criteria we are using to guide the review that he could use to steer the conversation..

I propose to provide this, taken from the "coding" document I sent earlier and based on the EO and our discussions - any concerns? The Coalition is likely less interested in the last item but since it is in the EO I included it.

Whether there are Tribal cultural or historic sites not currently included in the monument or not adequately protected by the Proclamation or BLM regulations;

Whether the monument exceeds "the smallest area compatible with the proper care and management of the objects to be protected";

Whether protected resources in the monument are appropriately classified as "historic landmarks, historic and prehistoric structures,

[or] other objects of historic or scientific interest";

The effects of a designation on the use and enjoyment of non-Federal lands within or beyond monument boundaries; and

The effects of a designation on the available uses of designated Federal lands, including consideration of the multiple-use policy of section 102(a)(7) of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act (43 U.S.C. 1701(a)(7)), as well as the effects on the available uses of Federal lands beyond the monument boundaries;
