Since National Monuments designated under the authority of the Antiquities Act are the focus of the inquiry, it might be best to focus on those. They are denoted by the a proclamation number, which is the method for designation of National Monument using the authorities in the Antiquities Act.

I spoke briefly with the Byron Loosley and he mentioned that they could provide their yearly reports. The information in the reports was provided by you all, so the information might be similar to what you all already have in your database. They track the information by state, so

perhaps we could provide the Congressional Research Office with the state figures for comparison.
