Hi Allan,

Attached is a spreadsheet of the GSENM SRPs that we have categorized as hunting operators. I pulled the SRP electronic records from 2011-2016. Records prior to 2011 were not tracked well electronically, and cannot be easily compiled by the due date. This Excel document contains sheets for each individual year, as well as an averaged sheet for 2011-2016. It documents:

- SRP Name
- Fees collected for SRP hunting operations on GSENM (3% of adjusted gross income)
- Total number of hunting participants on GSENM
- Total number of hunting days on GSENM

There are at least two additional SRPs who are authorized for hunting and fishing operations (Ruby's Inn & Escalante Outfitters, respectively) who are not included here, because we have them categorized under their primary SRP activities (equestrian use and day hiking, respectively) and cannot easily break out their hunting/fishing use data.

That's the specifics. The bigger picture would include the Programmatic EA for SRPs, which was signed in 2012. It allows GSENM to respond and process SRP applications in a more timely manner, increasing opportunities and providing greater customer service to hunting & fishing operators. This EA and associated permit stipulations include measures to protect wildlife and wildlife services, such as the 9-mile buffer between domestic sheep/goats and desert bighorn sheep habitat. I don't know if this EA can be easily plugged into the data request spreadsheet, or if it's already been covered by other peoples.

Let me know if there's anything additional that I can get you.

Allan:

I would like you to take the lead in ensuring that this short turn around Data request is completed by the March 16 at noon deadline to the UTSO. This comes from the Secretarial Order that Larry C passed out at MLT this week. We need to compile GSENM actions to implement [Executive Order 13443](#), Facilitation of Hunting Heritage and Wildlife Conservation, President George W. Bush's Executive Order signed in 2007.
Here is the list of what they are looking for:

Actions Requested: Please provide the consolidated actions completed by your State/Center/Directorate under Section 2 of Executive Order 13443 that:

- (a) Evaluate the effect of agency actions on trends in hunting participation and, where appropriate to address declining trends, implement actions that expand and enhance hunting opportunities for the public;*
- (b) Consider the economic and recreational values of hunting in agency actions, as appropriate;*
- (c) Manage wildlife and wildlife habitats on public lands in a manner that expands and enhances hunting opportunities, including through the use of hunting in wildlife management planning;*
- (d) Work collaboratively with State governments to manage and conserve game species and their habitats in a manner that respects private property rights and State management authority over wildlife resources;*
- (e) Establish short and long term goals, in cooperation with State and tribal governments, and consistent with agency missions, to foster healthy and productive populations of game species and appropriate opportunities for the public to hunt those species;*
- (f) Ensure that agency plans and actions consider programs and recommendations of comprehensive planning efforts such as State Wildlife Action Plans, the North American Waterfowl Management Plan, and other range-wide management plans for big game and upland game birds;*
- (g) Seek the advice of State and tribal fish and wildlife agencies, and, as appropriate, consult with the Sporting Conservation Council and other organizations, with respect to the foregoing Federal activities;*

Additional actions to report:

- (h) Concrete actions currently being worked on that support the goals of EO 13443 such as Recreation & Public Purposes leases being developed for shooting ranges;*
- (i) Partnership success stories that support the goals of EO 13443;*
- (j) Other actions that support the goals of EO 13443.*

I think we have quite a few items to contribute for GSENM. Most are from the Resource Division, but we may also be able to consider the number of SRPs we have issued for Hunting/Fishing and our work with the Outfitters and Guides (Claire & Brian)

Other thoughts are: Bighorn sheep and antelope reintroductions, the wildlife fence, guzzlers on BLM, guzzler lids, wildlife ladders in tanks, habitat improvement projects...etc, etc.,

Lets pull together a great list of GSENM accomplishments.
