In my conversation with the purse seine rep yesterday, he said he did not believe the long-liners were interested in that area, but he qualified that with the fact that he only represented the purse seiners. (Something else I will check with NOAA.) I got a follow-up email from him today; he spoke last night to the head of the tuna association, who owns 3 long-liners, and that gentleman referenced only an interest in the Remote Islands. It is my long-time understanding that Rose Atoll is too far from the main islands for recreational or small-boat commercial fishermen to go there even before the Monument, but will check that with FWS.

Here is the draft memo, with the map and the 2 figures showing whale/dolphin congregations scanned as a second attachment. As requested, I have reformatted it to conform to the Bears Ears outline.

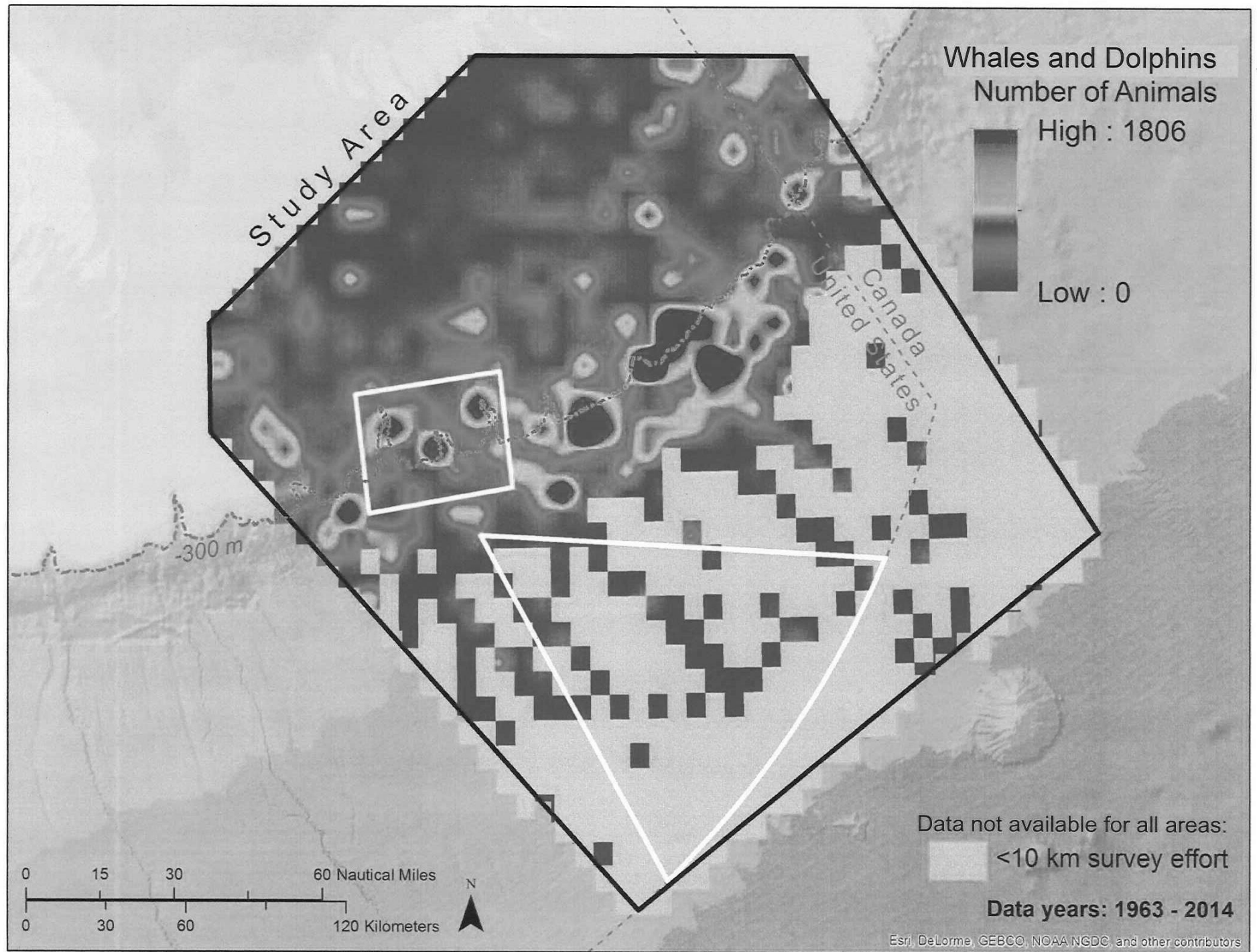
