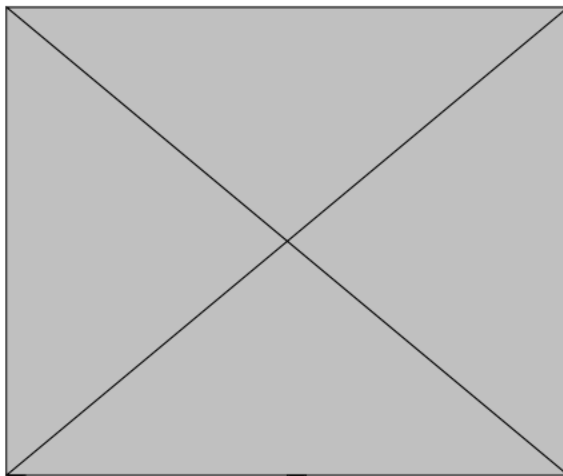

<h2>Interior Report Recommends Cuts or Changes to Seven Land Monuments</h2> <p>Interior Secretary Ryan Zinke has recommended cutbacks or other changes to nearly half the geographic national monuments he recently reviewed at the request of President Donald Trump, according to a report sent to the White House and reviewed by The Wall Street Journal.</p> <p>The report recommends reducing the boundaries of the Bears Ears and Grand Staircase-Escalante preserves in Utah, and reopening hundreds of thousands of square miles of protected oceans in both the Pacific and Atlantic to commercial fishing.</p> <p>Those are the findings in a report the secretary sent to Mr. Trump in August.
