Hi Folks, Going back several years, Kevin Miller and NAU received funding to look at the integration of historic and contemporary range related data. They submitted a final report back in June 2017. It is attached here and a short read

The information is dated and the report summarizes on the only data sets that were complete enough to summarize. They include: (1) lentic and lotic PFC for a select number of years; (2) Upland - Rangeland health indicators 2001-2003; and (3) AIM 2013.

The report has little in the way of results however, in a conversation with Kevin Miller, he said a lot of good "lessons learned" came out of the conversations this project generated but were not documented. These lessons learned might help bolster the value of the report. In order to generate these lessons learned, Kevin suggested he would help facilitate a discussion with the range specialists. I would document these and ask NAU to incorporate them into the final report.
