Executive Orders

September 29, 2017

***Presidential Executive Order on the Continuance of Certain Federal Advisory Committees***

Provided that each advisory committee listed continued until September 30, 2019 including:  
San Juan Islands National Monument Advisory Committee; Proclamation 8947 of March 25, 2013  
Bears Ears National Monument Advisory Committee; Proclamation 9558 of December 28, 2016  
Gold Butte National Monument Advisory Committee; Proclamation 9559 of December 28, 2016

April 26, 2017

***Executive Order 13792 on the Review of Designations under the Antiquities Act***

Initiated the review, by the Department of the Interior (DOI), of National Monuments (18 BLM NM's)  
designated under the Antiquities Act since January 1, 1996 that exceed 100,000 acres.

April 28, 2017

***Executive Order 13795: Presidential Executive Order Implementing an America-First Offshore Energy Strategy***

August 28, 2017

***Presidential Executive Order on Restoring State, Tribal, and Local Law Enforcement's Access to Life-Saving Equipment and Resources***

***Presidential Executive Order on Establishing Discipline and Accountability in the Environmental Review and Permitting Process for Infrastructure***

***Presidential Executive Order on the White House Initiative to Promote Excellence and Innovation at Historically Black Colleges and Universities***

***Secretarial Order 3346, Revocation of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service Director's Order No. 219 (Use of Nontoxic Ammunition and Fishing Tackle)***

Purpose: Rescind Director's Order No. 219, Use of Non-Toxic Ammunition and fish tackle. This Order is not mandated by statute and was issued without significant coordination with stakeholders.

Deliverables: Director of Fish and Wildlife Service to take all actions necessary to implement the revocation.

March 2, 2017

***Secretarial Order 3347: Conservation Stewardship and Outdoor Recreation***

Purpose: Expand recreation and conservation opportunities for all Americans.

Deliverables: Two reports as listed below:

Report to the Secretary within 30 calendar days on actions taken to implement Executive Order 13443, *Facilitation of Hunting Heritage and Wildlife Conservation*, actions that have not occurred, and recommendations for actions to improve implementation going forward; reports should explain any barriers that have prevented or slowed implementation of E.O. 13443.

Report to the Secretary with recommendations to enhance fishing, especially recreational fishing access.

March 27, 2017

***Secretarial Memo, Improving the Bureau of Land Management's Planning and National Environmental Policy Act Processes***

Purpose: The public thinks National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process is too lengthy and expensive and that staff time would be better spent on-the-ground. We need a quicker, less expensive process that is responsive to local needs.

Deliverable: A hard look at all aspects of the planning process, that includes NEPA challenges and incorporates the views of state and local parties, and report in 6 months on progress toward implementing improvements to the Land Use Planning and NEPA process. The report should include recommendations for legal and regulatory changes.

March 29, 2017

***Secretarial Order 3348: Lifting the Federal Coal Moratorium***

Purpose: The Federal Coal Leasing Program is of critical importance but Secretarial Order 3338 placed a moratorium on new coal leases, with limited exceptions, and required the BLM to enhance and improve the Federal Coal Leading Program. S.O. 3348 lifts the moratorium.

Deliverable: The BLM is directed to process coal leases and modifications expeditiously in accordance with pre-existing regulations, and cease all activities associated with preparation of the Federal Coal Program Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement. The Deputy Secretary,

Assistant Secretaries, and bureau Directors are required to change policy and guidance documents to be consistent with the revocation of S.O. 3338.

March 29, 2017

***Secretarial Order 3349: Promoting Energy Independence and Economic Growth***

Purpose: Revoke Secretarial Order 3330, Improving Mitigation policies and practice of the Department of the Interior and review actions directed by the March 28, 2017 Executive Order, Promoting Energy Independence and Economic Growth. The E.O. rescinded certain Presidential Actions, reports, and guidance related to climate change and mitigation, and directed agencies to review all existing regulations, orders, guidance documents, and policies that potentially burden the development or utilization of domestically produced energy resources.

Deliverables: The BLM must review of all actions taken pursuant to S.O. 3330 or any of the guidance rescinded by the March 28, 2017.

May 1, 2017

***Secretarial Order 3350, America-First Offshore Energy Strategy.***

Purpose: Implement the President's Executive Order, Implementing an America-First Offshore Energy Strategy, enhance opportunities for energy exploration, leasing, and development on the Outer Continental Shelf, establish regulatory certainty for OCS activities, and enhance conservation stewardship, thereby providing jobs, energy security, and revenue.

Deliverable: No BLM deliverable.

May 1, 2017

***Secretarial Order 3351, Strengthening the Department of the Interior's Energy Portfolio***

Purpose: Establish the position of Counselor to the Secretary for Energy Policy to ensure deliberate and active coordination of energy policy in the Department.

Deliverable: No BLM deliverable.

May 31, 2017

***Secretarial Order 3352, National Petroleum Reserve-Alaska***

Purpose: Provide for clean and safe development of our Nation's vast energy resources to ensure the Nation's geopolitical security, while avoiding regulatory burdens that unnecessarily encumber energy production, constrain economic growth, and prevent job creation.

Deliverable: The Assistant Secretary Lands and Minerals will provide to the Counselor to the Secretary of Energy Policy: A schedule to effectuate lawful review and development of a revised integrated Activity Plan for NPR-A; an evaluation, under the existing plan, on maximizing tracts offered for sale in the next NPR-A lease sale; A joint plan with the Assistant Secretary--Water and Science within 21 days, updating current assessments of undiscovered, technically recoverable oil and natural gas resources of the Northern slope, focusing on Federal Lands including NPR-A and

the Section 1002 Area; Within 31 days, the Counselor shall provide a plan to the Secretary a plan to complete the review.

June 2, 2017

***Joint BLM and USDA Secretarial Memo, 2017 Direction to the Wildland Fire Leadership***

Problem: Drought and an increased fuel load have elevated fire activity, which is increasingly costly and risks lives. The BLM and USDA need to provide the right tools, resources and flexibility so the job is done safely and effectively.

Deliverable: Agency administrators and fire managers are expected to adhere to good principles for safety, communication, collaboration, training, and management.

June 7, 2017

***Secretarial Order 3353, Greater Sage-Grouse Conservation and Cooperation with Western States***

Purpose: Enhance cooperation between the Department of Interior and States in management and conservation of Sage Grouse; support a partnership with clearly defined objectives and roles for Federal and State entities responsible for healthy populations of the species;

Deliverables:

The BLM must establish a team to review the Sage-Grouse plan amendments and revisions completed on or before September 2015; and Within 60 days the Sage Grouse team shall provide a report summarizing the plan review and provide recommendations regarding additional steps the Department should take to address any issues identified in the review.

September 15, 2017,

***Secretarial Order 3356 Hunting, Fishing, Recreational Shooting, and Wildlife Conservation Opportunities and Coordination with States, Tribes, and Territories (SO 3356).***

Assistant Directors were asked to create an action plan on how the BLM will address the objectives outlined in SO 3356. Attached is the requested action plan and associated information on implementing the actions identified in SO 3356.

## Presidential Memorandum

January 23, 2017

***Presidential Memorandum Regarding the Hiring Freeze***

Within 90 days of the date of this memorandum, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), in consultation with the Director of OPM, shall recommend a long-term plan to reduce the size of the Federal Government's workforce through attrition. This order shall expire upon implementation of the OMB plan.
