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T/W 5/9-10: Secretary will continue travel to Bears Ears and Grand Staircase Escalante.

Long Range: 5/25-5/28. The Secretary will participate in a CODEL sponsored by Senator Murkowski. Arctic Council. Norway, Greenland, Alaska. Various AK events 5/29-5/31.

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Emergency Management

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USGS deployed 5 crews in Missouri within the Gasconade, Meramec, Current, St. Francis, and Big River basins. Over 30 stream gages experienced record peaks within the White, Arkansas, and lower Mississippi basins. Additional high water mark crews are being deployed for peak verification to support anticipated Annual Exceedance Probability computations. The Indiana-Kentucky Water Science Center also deployed 5 crews to determine discharge

measurements in Indiana and Kentucky, where the lower Patoka basin is expected to experience major category flooding later this week.
