I knew he had been selected but I haven't met him yet.

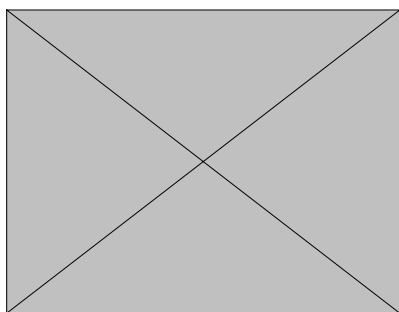
