VI. Weekly Report: (ALREADY UPDATED)

Week Ahead Announcements and Actions

On November 27, the USGS Research Drilling Unit is tentatively scheduled to begin drilling a dual-depth, shallow groundwater monitoring well in support of California's Casa Diablo IV Geothermal Development Project. The monitoring well is a required component of the BLM-CA Bishop Field Office approved Groundwater Monitoring and Response Plan for the project. The well is being drilled under a Special Use Permit issued to the BLM by the Inyo National Forest. The USGS will be responsible for monitoring this well for the BLM pursuant to the approved monitoring plan and an interagency agreement between the two agencies.

On November 27 - December 1, BLM-CO is tentatively planning to release an environmental assessment of a community-based proposal for an off-highway vehicle trail system for public review. Rio Blanco County submitted the Wagon Wheel West OHV Trail proposal to BLM to increase trail system-based recreation throughout the county and northwestern Colorado. The county proposes to develop a 384-mile off-highway vehicle route system incorporating mostly existing roads managed by BLM and the county.

On November 29 - 31, BLM Deputy Director for Policy Director Brian Steed (tentative) and BLM-NM Acting State Director Aden Seidlitz will attend the Western Regional Partnership Principal's Meeting in Phoenix, AZ. The WRP Co-Chairs from the State of Utah, Department of the Interior and Department of Defense will facilitate a discussion among regional leaders on key issues and priorities. Together, the principals will develop strategies and actions for addressing identified issues and priorities over the next year.

On November 29, BLM-WY employees from across the state will attend the Wyoming Stock Growers Convention at the Ramkota Inn in Casper. The convention will be hosted by the Wyoming Stock Growers Association and the Wyoming Association of Conservation Districts. BLM representatives will participate at two meetings during the convention: a federal agencies' meeting and a federal lands committee meeting. Likely topics for discussion include: tribal consultation, outcome based grazing permits and sage grouse habitat planning. Members of the public and the media are likely to attend.

On November 30, BLM-AK will provide a monthly right-of-way application update on the Donlin Gold project to Donlin Gold representatives. BLM-AK Planning and Environmental Specialist Laurie Thorpe and Anchorage Field Office Manager Bonnie Million will present the update.

On December 1 - 2, BLM Deputy Director for Policy Brian Steed will attend the Western Governors' Association Annual Meeting in Phoenix, AZ. The meeting will feature keynotes by Transportation Secretary Elaine Chao, John Ratzenberger and the NFL's Michael Bidwill, as well as discussions on significant western issues, including the changing face of the West, energy, and autonomous vehicles.

30 - 60 Day Look-Ahead

On December 5, BLM-AK Acting State Director Karen Mouritsen and North Slope Science Initiative Executive Director Sara Longan will participate in the Conservation of Arctic Flora and Fauna (CAFF) Alaska Partners meeting in Anchorage. The CAFF is the biodiversity working group of the Arctic Council. This meeting will be the planning and pre-brief for the Feb. 5-7 meeting of the CAFF Management Board in Fairbanks and Chena Hot Springs, Alaska. Sara Longan will offer updates on the CAFF Circumpolar Biodiversity Monitoring Program and summarize contributions by BLM and other federal agencies involved.

On December 6, BLM-AK will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 900 tracts totaling 10.3 million acres in the NPR-A. There have been 12 previous NPR-A lease sales since 1999, but this one will be the first NPR-A lease to take place using livestream video. In addition, this is the first time that all available tracts will be offered for lease, which is a potential source of controversy. Further controversy is expected if BLM-AK modifies the Integrated Activity Plan prior to the sale. Bidding is expected to be moderate.

On December 6, ASLM Deputy Assistant Secretary Casey Hammond will give the keynote address at the American Exploration and Mining Association Conference in Sparks, NV. Mr. Hammond's address will focus on Federal Register Notices (NOI/NOA), Greater sage-grouse, cancellation of the SFA proposed mineral withdrawal, permitting and NEPA compliance.

On December 7, BLM-CO Colorado River Valley Field Office Inspection and Enforcement Program Manager Steve Ficklin will give an update at the quarterly Northwest Colorado Oil and Gas Forum in Rifle. The Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission and Garfield County sponsor the forum. Ficklin will also give an update at the monthly Garfield County Energy Advisory Board, also in Rifle. Both meetings will be attended by industry representatives and will be open to the public with opportunities for public comment. Updates will focus on the status of current projects, permitting and leasing.

On December 7, BLM-NM will hold an oil and gas lease sale for seven parcels totaling 2,104 acres in Eddy and Lea Counties. The sale is expected to be controversial and is likely to be protested by environmental groups concerned with the potential impacts of hydraulic fracturing on air and water quality. The bidding is expected to be robust.

On December 7, BLM-CO will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 28 parcels totaling 27,284 acres in Garfield and Mesa counties. The sale is not expected to be controversial due to the lack of a significant number of protests received and lack of media coverage.

On December 7, BLM Senior Advisor Kathy Benedetto will give the keynote address at the Public Lands session of the American Exploration and Mining Association Conference in Sparks, NV. Benedetto's remarks will focus on opportunities for the mining industry to work with the Administration in light of ongoing regulatory reform and energy development efforts undertaken in connection with various Executive and Secretary's Orders that have been issued since the beginning of the Administration.

On December 12, BLM-NV will hold an online oil and gas lease sale for 208 parcels, totaling 388,959.402 acres in White Pine, Lincoln and Nye Counties. The sale will likely be controversial. Nevada has received comments from the EPA, Center for Biological Diversity, Great Basin Water District and Nevada Department of Wildlife, regarding a variety of concerns including impacts to air quality, water resources and sensitive species. Nevada has three registered bidders at this point and anticipate having more before the sale.

On December 12, BLM-MT will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 204 parcels totaling 98,889 acres in Big Horn, Custer, Carter, Fallon, Garfield, Powder River, Richland, and Rosebud Counties. BLM-MT

expects minimal controversy with this sale, but also anticipates that bidding will not be expected to be robust.

On December 14, BLM-Eastern States will hold an oil and gas lease sale for seven parcels totaling 1,185 acres in OH and LA. The sale will include five parcels totaling 350.06 acres in the Wayne National Forest, Monroe County, OH; and two parcels totaling 834.70 acres in the Kisatchie National Forest, Natchitoches and Winn Parishes, LA. The parcels being offered in the Wayne National Forest are expected to be controversial because several environmental groups want hydraulic fracturing in the area prohibited. There is interest in the sale as indicated by approximately 100 Expressions of Interest received by the BLM Eastern States for parcels underlying the Wayne.

On December 14, BLM-UT will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 75 parcels totaling 94,041 acres in Duchesne, Uintah and Emery Counties. The sale is expected to be controversial due to the nomination of parcels near Dinosaur National Monument. Two of the three parcels nominated by industry for consideration near the boundary of the Monument have been deferred pending consultation with the NPS. The remaining parcel contains both BLM-managed and split estate land, with a small portion in view of the monument. The BLM, however, has applied stipulations for light and noise pollution, and to minimize impacts to air quality and the scenic view shed. Bidding is expected to be robust.

On December 14, BLM-WY will hold an oil and gas lease sale for 45 parcels totaling 72,843 acres in Laramie, Sweetwater, Uinta and Lincoln Counties. The sale is not anticipated to be controversial. Bidding is not expected to be robust.

On December 14, BLM-CA Bakersfield Field Office will host a public scoping meeting in Three Rivers to gather comments on a draft of a vegetation and forest health plan for the BLM's only giant sequoia grove on Case Mountain. During the meeting, the public will have an opportunity to view maps about the plan and talk with BLM specialists about some of the fire prevention options, which include removal of trees, clearing of underbrush, and prescribed fire. The BLM anticipates local media coverage and a mixed reaction from the public. The BLM manages approximately 444 acres on Case Mountain, which supports the Giant Sequoia Complex and the Case Mountain Extensive Recreation Management Area. Non-mechanized public access offers miles of mountain bike, hiking and horseback riding trails, picnic tables, wildlife watching and photography in the foothills of the Sierras. The area is also part of the 20,000-acre Kaweah Area of Critical Environmental Concern, designated for the protection of the six distinct giant sequoia groves, other sensitive plant and animal species, riverbank ecosystems and culturally significant areas.

On December 14, BLM-AK Associate State Director Ted Murphy will provide an update to the Western Arctic Caribou Herd Working Group on development activities within the National Petroleum Reserve in Alaska. The group brings a broad range of stakeholders together who are actively involved in the management of caribou and includes subsistence users, other hunters, reindeer herders, hunting guides, transporters and conservationists. The BLM assists the group by coordinating these annual meetings.

On December 15, BLM-CA Bakersfield Field Office will meet with the California Resources Corporation (CRC), the California Department of Fish and Wildlife and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to discuss CRC's proposal to donate its mineral estate in the Carrizo Plain National Monument in exchange for mitigation credit for projects conducted in the San Joaquin Valley. The BLM is strictly a facilitator for these meetings and does not anticipate having to make a decision.

On January 6 - 8, BLM will host a meeting to develop an interagency strategy to contain the spread of quagga mussels from the Lower Colorado River at the Colorado River District/Lake Havasu Field Office

in Lake Havasu, AZ. Development of this strategy was identified as one of the Department of the Interior's top priorities to prevent the introduction and spread of invasive mussels in the June report to the Western Governors Association. This meeting is intended to bring together the federal, state, tribal, and local agencies, and other partners to develop and draft a Lower Colorado River Strategy to Contain the Spread of Invasive Mussels. The anticipated outcome is a coordinated, area-wide containment effort by all parties, within the scope of their regulations and resources, focusing on inspection and decontamination of long-term watercraft (5 days), including outreach, education and inspection.

On January 28 -February 2, BLM Nevada State Director John Ruhs will attend the Society for Range Management Annual Meeting in Sparks, NV. The theme of this year's conference is "Empowerment through Applied Science." Ruhs, a 30-year member of SRM, will speak at a session about the BLM's Wild Horse and Burro program, serve on a panel at the producers' forum and judge the college poster contest.

On January 31, BLM-CA will participate in an oil and gas operator seminar that focuses on surface and environmental requirements associated with new oil and gas projects (APDs and Sundry Notices). On average, the BLM is able to permit APDs in a 30-45 day period, due to assistance from operators in getting needed information to the BLM in a timely manner. The BLM plans to give the seminar participants a refresher on the items the BLM needs in regards to biological, cultural and paleontology review to ensure a quick turnaround when new permits are submitted.
