Thanks, Larry. Very helpful. Copying Louise because she was involved with this at NOAA. We just spoke briefly about this litigation with Jack and Dan. The upshot is:

1. White House Counsel is unlikely to take lead on this--so it will be up to SOL and NOAA/OGC to staff it out (although there should be coordination with White House Counsel). That will mean you and someone at NOAA. Larry, maybe you and I should call Adam Issenberg to discuss. Louise, do you have any thoughts about the role of NOAA in the defense of the case?
2. Dan would like to learn more about the case, so we probably schedule a briefing for him. Larry, when is you next day at DOI?
