I had an unavoidable errand this morning. Downey is out until noon. Came by to talk on this, but you were out, and I don't want to delay further, so this email.

I do not see the point of providing cites for our own interpretations and conclusions in something we release. BOEM has the sole authority to lease oil, gas, minerals and renewable energy on the Outer Continental Shelf, their approved statements on those issues are accordingly authoritative, and all of the material relative to this is from them, approved by Kate MacGregor, acting Assistant Secretary for Land and Minerals, and Downey for transmittal to NOAA.

Preparing specific protection questions might still miss something critical due to the complexity of laws and regulations for commercial fishing, as well as further delaying transmittal of the memo. If you are concerned they would hesitate to revise/comment on what we have, a concern I don't have, I suggest inserting a general "Note" at the start of the fishing section that this is our interpretation of what is on various NOAA web sites, but please review and revise as needed, and then send the memo, not questions, ASAP. This is a cooperative effort, and we don't need to provide them a fully polished product at this point, just a discussion or review draft. Further delay could erode that cooperation.
