In response to my inquiries, NMFS said the following:

Commerce has never been formally asked nor formally prepared a
recommendation for the marine monuments. Occasionally, the White House

would ask us for facts about the area and we would provide them but there is not a recommendation package or supporting documents that we prepared.

Michael also added:

The only other data point pertains to the original establishment of Papahānaumokuākea. We had engaged in an almost 5-year planning process and prepared designation documents (draft NEPA analysis, draft management plan, etc) for a proposed national marine sanctuary, which instead at the 11th hour was established as the monument under the Antiquities Act. The draft sanctuary management plan was referenced in the monument proclamation to be the basis for a monument management plan.

We are checking to see if the draft sanctuary management plan is available.
