



Seasonal FIRE Employment Bureau of Land Management Idaho 2019

The BLM manages more land – approximately 253 million acres - than any other Federal agency. This land, known as the National System of Public Lands, is primarily located in 12 Western states, including Alaska. The Bureau, with a budget of about \$1 billion, also administers 700 million acres of sub-surface mineral estates throughout the nation. Pay

Most temporary positions are paid via General Schedule (GS) grades, GS-3 through GS-7 or via Wage Grade (WG), WG-3 through WG-10. **The hourly GS rates for 2019 are expected to increase 1.5% from the 2018 rates for Idaho which are as follows:**

Requirements

All applicants must be a United States citizen and at least 18 years of age by the time of appointment. Applicants with experience or

training in the fields for which they are applying may qualify at higher grades.

All positions require the applicant to pass a physical examination and drug test. All applicants will be considered without regard to political, religious, or labor organization affiliation or non-affiliation, marital status, race, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, non-disqualifying physical or mental disability, or age.
