

FIRE RESTRICTIONS ORDER LIFTED SPOKANE DISTRICT BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT

Fire restrictions are hereby lifted on lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and the Bureau of Reclamation (BOR) in eastern Washington will take. This will take effect on 12:01 a.m. Friday, September 13, 2019, in the following eastern Washington counties: Adams, Asotin, Benton, Chelan, Columbia, Douglas, Ferry, Franklin, Garfield, Grant, Kittitas, Klickitat, Lincoln, Okanogan, Pend Oreille, Spokane, Stevens, Walla Walla, Whitman, and Yakima.

On all federal public lands, ignition of fireworks is prohibited (43 CFR 9212.1(h)) and (43 CFR 423.30(c)). In addition, the use of exploding targets and incendiary bullets are also prohibited. Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment of not more than 12 months, or both.

This order will be effective 12:01 a.m. September 13, 2019.
