

FIRE RESTRICTIONS ORDER LIFTED SPOKANE DISTRICT BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT

All fire restrictions, including the temporary ban on target shooting, will be lifted on lands administered by the Spokane District Bureau of Land Management effective 12:01 a.m. Saturday, September 15, 2018. This order applies to the following eastern Washington counties: Adams, Asotin, Benton, Chelan, Columbia, Douglas, Ferry, Franklin, Garfield, Grant, Kittitas, Klickitat, Lincoln, Okanogan, Pend Oreille, Spokane, Stevens, Walla Walla, Whitman, and Yakima.

On all public lands within the Spokane District, ignition of fireworks is prohibited (43 CFR 9212.1(h)). In addition, the use of exploding targets and incendiary bullets are also prohibited. Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment of not more than 12 months, or both.

This order will be effective 12:01 a.m. on September 15, 2018.
