

Litigation

- Revised Jarbidge Field Office Resource Management Plan
- Record of Decision signed in 2015
 - Selected an alternative to implement the Saylor Creek HMA as non-reproducing.
 - A lawsuit was filed in 2015.
 - BLM was unsuccessful in court and the decision was remanded in 2017.
 - BLM is following the 1987 Jarbidge RMP for management of the Saylor Creek HMA

Soda Fire

- Soda Fire
 - A 2015 wildfire that burned approximately 280,000 acres in southwestern Idaho and southeastern Oregon.
 - Burned 100% of the Hardtrigger and Sands Basin HMAs and 33% of the Black Mountain HMA.
 - Significant emergency stabilization and rehabilitation efforts occurred.
