

## C. Definition of Terms

1. **Element:** An element refers to any natural resource, public use, or facility administration program as defined below for which goals and objectives have been prepared and presented within this plan.
2. **Resource element:** These elements consist of natural resource values for which specific management goals and objectives have been developed in the plan.
3. **Public use element:** Public use elements are any recreational, scientific, or other uses appropriate to and compatible with the purposes for which this property was acquired.
4. **Infrastructure and administration element:** This is a general purpose element describing facility development, maintenance and administrative program which must be implemented in order to maintain orderly and beneficial management of the area.
5. **Biological Goal:** A biological goal is the statement of intended long-range results of management based upon the feasibility of maintaining, enhancing or restoring species populations and/or habitat.
6. **Public use goal:** A public use goal is the statement of the desired type and level of public use compatible with the biological element goals previously specified within the plan.
7. **Objective:** Objectives are statements of intended results of management actions which promote the resource, public use, or infrastructure and administrative goals on the property.
8. **Action:** Actions are the individual projects or work elements which implement the objective and can be useful as an aid in budget planning for the property.
