Thank-you for meeting with us April 25th concerning the Red Devil Mine (RDM). In order to appropriately address data gaps presented in your February 22, 2008 letter about contamination at the RDM, we have submitted funding requests for the 2009 and future federal fiscal years. The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) intends to complete characterization and required cleanup efforts for petroleum contamination at the RDM following State of Alaska Regulations. BLM intends to address the State's metals contamination concerns at RDM following the National Contingency Plan's Remedial Process. We will continue to work closely with the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation and United States Environmental Protection Agency to address the data gaps outlined in your letter.
