
A few things to keep in mind as you enjoy the **Iditarod Sled Dog Race Ceremonial Start**:

- Free **shuttle buses** are available between parking lots and viewing areas near the airstrip and the Science Center.
- For your safety and the safety of sled dogs, please stay on designated viewing trails.
