Dear Oil and Gas Operator,

BLM-Alaska's Energy Section, now has an email address to be used for the purpose of industry reporting of **notifications** as required by various regulations and Conditions of Approval for all oil and gas operations on federal lands in Alaska. At this time, this email address is actively monitored by BLM's Petroleum Engineers and Inspectors, Tom Zelenka and Justin Miller. Should Tom or Justin anticipate being out of contact for any reason, a backup will be designated to ensure this address is monitored. Email notifications sent to this address are not a substitute for the submission of Sundry Notices, Form 3160-5, or NTL-3a (Alaska) requirement of immediate verbal notice for major undesirable events or written notice for all other undesirable events. Undesirable events shall continue to be reported verbally to the Authorized Officer, Wayne Svejnoha, when appropriate, and in writing or via AFMSS Electronic Commerce (EC) through Sharon Yarawsky, Mineral Law Specialist.

The following notification types are appropriate to send to
BLM_AK_AKSO_EnergySection_Notifications@blm.gov :

- Well spud notices
- 48-hour notice of BOPE testing
- BOPE testing results and charts
- 48-hour notice of setting casing
- Meter/LACT calibration notices
- Meter/LACT calibration results and run tickets

As always, BLM's Petroleum Engineers are available via Blackberry in the event last minute notice must be given, verbal approval is needed, or an emergency has occurred onsite that required action contrary to our regulation.
