



Supplement D – Interim Management Plan

Application for Permits to Mine in Alaska (APMA)- BLM Supplement D – Interim Management Plan

All Plans of Operations must contain an interim management plan. These plans establish actions required for periods of temporary or seasonal closure under 43 CFR 3809.424 to avoid causing unnecessary or undue degradation. There are six items that must be described in the interim management plan:

- 1) Schedule of anticipated periods of temporary closure.
- 2) Plans for monitoring site conditions during periods of non-operation.
- 3) Measures to stabilize excavations and workings, such as settling ponds, especially for those sites subject to significant spring flooding or aufeis (freezing overflow).
- 4) Measures to isolate or control toxic or deleterious materials, such as fuel.
- 5) Provisions for the storage or removal of equipment, supplies, and structures.
- 6) Measures to maintain the project area in a safe and clean condition.
