## Tips for being a safe rider:

1. Wear proper clothing, a helmet that fits, goggles, and a transmitting avalanche beacon.
2. Be prepared! Always go out with enough fuel, a tool kit, safety kit, and rescue gear.
3. Plan your trip before you go. Tell someone where you're headed and when you expect to be back.
4. Ride sober.
5. Respect other trail users, private property, and the environment.

## How To Enter

1. Bring Flat Rider along on your next ride and take a picture of the two of you having an epic day. Remember to be safe and creative!
