Anchorage 4-H and the BLM Campbell Creek Science Center present this year's Science Saturday line-up. The sessions target 9- to 13-year-olds and focus on science and the natural world. Adults and youths partner



together in the program to explore, discover, and learn. After each program you'll go home with greater awareness of the environment and the role of science in understanding our world!



The sessions take place at the Campbell Creek Science Center and **start promptly at 1:00 pm**. Part of each day will be spent outside; don't be late or you'll miss the group! The sessions also include time for informal sharing, debrief, refreshments, and a chance to learn about Anchorage 4-H.

- October 16 "Get Your Hands Dirty"** – Get up close and personal with soil, rocks, and minerals by taking measurements and making outdoor observations.
- November 13 "Get Energized"** – In the months of big heating and lighting bills come explore the sources of energy on our planet AND get yourself energized with our fun outdoor activities.
- December 4 "Geocache 101"** – A favorite activity for all generations! Learn GPS and navigation basics, then get out and test your skill in our geocache course.
- January 8 "Science Fair Boot Camp"** – Master the scientific process in preparation for making top notch science fair projects.
- February 26 "Avalanche and Arctic Survival"** – It takes years to be an expert, but with our tips and techniques you can be better equipped to explore the Alaskan winter.
- March 19 "Tracking and Snowshoeing"** – Learn to identify evidence of Alaskan animals, big and small. Strap into a pair of our snowshoes and experience the Campbell Tract in a new way.
- April 16 "Climate Change at the Poles"** – Alaska and Antarctica are the top locations for scientists studying climate change. Come learn how they do it and what they've found.
- May 7 "Stream Studies"** – Come measure the health of Campbell Creek by looking at pH, dissolved oxygen, critters that might live there, and other data. A great day to wear your hip-waders or break-up boots!
