

User Responsibilities

The following points are a quick and easy guide to our expectations for those who use the buildings and grounds:

- User groups are in charge of their own set-up and takedown.
- User groups are also responsible for cleaning up, including vacuuming and leaving the Center in the same condition in which it was found. Upon arrival you should receive a cleaning checklist from the front desk staff member.
- Remember that you are in bear and moose country. Practice appropriate bear and moose safety while along the trails. Be careful not to leave any food, even food scraps, for any large or small critters.
- Large user groups are encouraged to carpool since only limited parking is available at the Science Center.
- The Campbell Creek Science Center requires that each educational group of 15 or fewer students have one adult chaperone in addition to the Science Center instructor.
- Please stay on the trails. Revegetation projects are in progress around the Science Center and your cooperation will be appreciated.
- Campbell Airstrip is an active runway. For safety reasons it is mandatory that all visitors, including rental groups and program attendees, stay off of the airstrip at all times.
- Customer parking can be found just left of the end of the Science Center road. There is handicap parking on the East side of the customer parking lot, as well as one space on each end of the Science Center building. If you have any equipment to unload you may use the service (west) entrance. However, we ask that once you have unloaded your vehicle you park in the customer parking area.
- The consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited at the Campbell Creek Science Center, on the associated grounds, and on Campbell Tract.
- Smoking is prohibited inside the Science Center building. However, there is a designated smoking area located 40 feet away from the building in our employee parking area.
- Pets are not allowed inside the Science Center except for guide dogs for the visually impaired.
- In the event of an emergency please direct all of your group members out to the Emergency Assembly Area, located in the main parking lot by the furthest lamppost.
- Inclement weather may occasionally require the early closure of federal facilities, including the Science Center. If there is an early closure, BLM-led educational programs & rentals will continue until all students/attendees have left or an event has ended. In the event that inclement weather occurs *before* the start of your program or rental, please call 566-0023. If the Anchorage Federal Building is closed, the Science Center will be closed as well.
