




## Camping Prohibited in the Toolik Lake Research Natural Area

The Dalton Highway crosses the Toolik Lake Research Natural Area (RNA) north of Galbraith Lake between mileposts 278 and 293. The BLM established the RNA in 1991 for scientific research on arctic ecosystems. Day use is allowed in the RNA, but **camping is prohibited** without prior written approval from the BLM.

Toolik Lake Field Station, operated by the University of Alaska, is closed to visitors except by invitation. No public services are available.

A BLM campground (no fee) is located on the west side of Galbraith Lake, 4 miles (6.4 km) from the Dalton Highway at milepost 275.
