AREA DESCRIPTION:

This project is for the management of recreation fees generated from the sale of America the Beautiful Interagency Passes, as well as the administration of the Special Recreation Permit (SRP) Program outside of Special Management Areas. Permits for the year included those for hunter/guide services, vendors, nature hikes, and wilderness education.

FEE SCHEDULE:

Fees for the SRP program are established at the national level by the BLM Director. Effective April 1, 2008, the minimum commercial, competitive and organized group use fees were adjusted based on the Gross National Product Implicit Price Deflator Index in accordance with the automatic three-year fee adjustment policy published on October 19, 1989 (see WO IM No. 2008-106). The minimum annual commercial and/or competitive fee was \$95.

America the Beautiful Interagency Passes:

- Annual: \$85
- Senior: \$10
- Access: Free

SPECIFIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR FY09:

Repair, Maintenance, and Facility Enhancement:

Fee revenues from FY09 were spent on registration boxes, trail and directional signs, and site area signs, as well as for necessary supplies, such as posts, hardware, and cement for the installation of the signs. The signing projects funded with recreation fee revenues from the AZ15 account benefit both SRP users and general visitors to the Safford Field Office.

PROJECTS/ACTIVITIES PLANNED FOR FY10:

- Continue with sign replacement and installation, supplies and maintenance.
