<b>NAME OF FEE PROJECT: AZ09 PAINTED ROCK PETROGLYPH SITE AND CAMPGROUND</b>	<b>STATE: AZ</b>
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**AREA DESCRIPTION:**

Painted Rock Petroglyph Site and Campground provides visitors the opportunity to view an ancient archaeological site containing hundreds of symbolic and artistic rock etchings, or “petroglyphs” produced centuries ago by prehistoric peoples. There are also inscriptions made by people who passed through the area during historic times. Many well-known events in Arizona history occurred near the petroglyph site, including the expedition of Juan Bautista de Anza that founded San Francisco, the Mormon Battalion and the Butterfield overland mail route. Picnic tables, barbeque grills, two ramadas, an interpretive trail, and two vault toilets are provided for visitors.

**FEE SCHEDULE:**

\$2.00/vehicle for day use; \$8.00/vehicle/camping

**SPECIFIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN FY10:**

**Visitor Services, Interpretation:**

The part-time volunteer campground host assisted with visitor contact/tours, visitor use statistics, and campground maintenance throughout the fiscal year. Funding for travel expenses and lunches was provided for the volunteer campground host with recreation fee revenues.

**Repair, Maintenance, and Facility Enhancement:**

The campground host provided maintenance of the campground including cleaning and restocking the restrooms, policing for trash/litter, restocking fee envelopes and ash removal from barbeque grills. Two handicapped-accessible sites were improved with new concrete pads and elevated grills, as well as maintaining two walkway paths and replacing six traffic and directional signs. The campground road loops were upgraded with rock/soil filler. Vault toilets were pumped by Septic Technologies and trash was collected under a contract with the Town of Gila Bend.

**PROJECTS/ACTIVITIES PLANNED FOR FY11:**

Depending on funding and day-use/camping fee collection, the following projects/activities are planned:

- Patch and seal two ramada floors
- Paint two ramadas
- Garbage collection and vault toilet maintenance

- Improve two handicapped-accessible camp sites
- Replace two information kiosks
- Replace three metal storage room doors
- Install concrete water crossing
