NAME OF FEE PROJECT: AZ15 SAFFORD FIELD OFFICE SRPs/AMERICA THE BEAUTIFUL INTERAGENCY PASSES		STATE: AZ
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DESCRIPTION:

This project is for the management of recreation fees generated from the administration of the Special Recreation Permit (SRP) Program outside of Special Management Areas. Permits for the year included those for hunter/guide services, vendors, nature hikes, and wilderness education.

FEE SCHEDULE:

The SRP fee schedule for commercial activities is established nationally for all BLM field offices. Fee receipts derived from recreational commercial, competitive, and organized group event SRPs are routinely calculated using national fee schedule guidance found in BLM Recreation Permit Administration Manual H-2930-1, Section III.G., as established by 43 CFR 2930. As of March 2008, the SRP fee schedule is the following:

- Commercial permits are the maximum of \$95 or 3% of the gross revenue.
- Competitive permits are the maximum of \$95, 3% of gross revenue or \$5 per participant/day.
- Organized-group use is \$5 per person per day or \$95, whichever is greater.

SPECIFIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN FY10:

REPAIR, MAINTENANCE, AND FACILITY ENHANCEMENT:

Fees in FY10 were spent on registration boxes, trail and directional signs, and site area signs, as well as for necessary supplies, such as posts, hardware, and cement for the installation of the signs. The signing projects funded with recreation fee revenues from the AZ15 account benefit both SRP users and general visitors to the Safford Field Office.

PROJECTS/ACTIVITIES PLANNED FOR FY10:

- Continue with sign replacement and installation, supplies and maintenance.
