Criteria: Parcels of public or private land that may require remediation or do not have higher resource values and may be suitable for renewable energy development. Examples include; hazardous material sites or brownfields, Abandoned Mine Lands sites, former land fill sites, inactive or exhausted mineral material sites or gravel pits, sites damaged or disturbed to the extent that restoration potential is limited, or sites with very limited productivity due to a disruption of natural processes (i.e. isolation from hydrological processes).
