Dear Mr. Incardine:

We are residents of Trilogy at Vistancia in Peoria. Several years ago we attended several meetings that were hosted by you and other representatives of BLM that were intended to convey plans formulated by Arizona Public Service Company (APS) to build a 38-mile-long overhead transmission line from the Morgan substation near Peoria and the planned Sun Valley substation near northern Buckeye.

Trilogy and Vistancia were well represented in at least two of those meetings. We voiced our objection to the original planned location of the transmission lines. Our concerns were with the potential health problems that could result from such close proximity to our residences and to the obvious decline in the fair market value of our homes. One of the alternatives suggested to the proposed route was the north side of Route 74, the Carefree Highway.

Representatives of BLM indicated that considerations would be given to alternate routes for the transmission lines. We are aware that to make changes to a project of this magnitude would require attention to a lot of factors. We also understand that BLM has proposed that the route, in fact, be installed to the North of Route 74. We strongly approve of this location.

We want to express our gratitude to you and other representatives of BLM for your support of the relocation of the lines. We are also grateful to APS for their consideration of these changes.

We are looking forward to the meeting tonight to hear the details.
