Please reject siting the proposed Sun Valley to Morgan 500/230kV Transmission Line Project on public lands. The proposed route could have tremendous negative impact on resources, including on sensitive desert tortoise habitat, recreational opportunities, scenic beauty and more.

The proposed site primarily benefits one developer, while sacrificing important public resources. The BLM should say no to the developer and continue to manage these lands for their natural resource values.

I strongly recommend that the BLM reject this proposal and keep this area off-limits to transmission lines and other development. Please select the No Action Alternative in the DEIS and do not amend the RMP. Keep our public lands public!
