

The noise and dreadful looking power lines that would be hanging near this beautiful area is really very upsetting to me as a home owner here in Vistancia. I had the opportunity to live by them for 3 years in the Military and do not want to live by them again, they are the worst when in a residential environment. The environmental impact on this community if they were too located here would be devastating to both Value and desire to live here. If by the way you go out on Vistancia blvd just north west of the 303 and the homes that were built under and around the power lines and talk with those people who own homes near them, you will find out the immediate impact they have had on that area. They also closed the Real Estate Office that was selling those homes. The NUMBER #1 complaint was that the hissing noise that they created was extremely loud and it was a continues noise 24 hours a day. It will drive you absolutely nuts to listen to that.

I am very pleased to know that BLM has stated great support for the Certificated Route and ask us for our support to that decision, you have our full support for that and it is a decision that is best for the environmental impact. The choice that the Arizona Corporation Commission had agreed to by moving the lines out of this community and on public land north of State Route #74 to permanently secure that location is by far a superior choice for this community.
