

Roles and Responsibilities

Bureau of Land Management (BLM)



- Preparing the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to comply with the National Environmental Policy Act (as the lead federal agency)
- Serving as project lead agency for Section 106 and Section 7 consultation under the National Historic Preservation Act and Endangered Species Act, respectively
- Issuing right-of-way grants on BLM lands authorizing the project (if approved)

Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation)



- Issuing right-of-way grant on Reclamation lands authorizing the project (if approved)
- Participating as cooperating agency in preparation of the EIS

Western Area Power Administration (Western)



- Approving or denying interconnection with an existing transmission line owned and operated by Western
- Participating as cooperating agency in preparation of the EIS

BP Wind Energy



- Developing, constructing, operating, and decommissioning the project (as the project proponent)

Cooperating Agencies and Tribes

- Providing information for environmental analyses based on special expertise or jurisdiction by law
