Plan decision requiring maintenance: Land Use Allocation – Disposal
Approximately 50,616 acres (see Appendix G) will be available for potential disposal by land tenure category as follows:

2,934 acres as current leases for disposal under the R&PP Act

47,682 acres as available for sale, exchange, and R&PP leasing and disposal

Reason(s) for maintenance: Map 14, Disposal Lands, shows the correct disposal area for T. 16 1/2N., R. 20 1/2W., sec 24, and T. 16 1/2N., R. 20 W., section 20. However, the legal description in Appendix G, page G-2, incorrectly lists all of section 24, and only a portion of section 20 as available for disposal. The legal tract shown for section 24 should be switched with the legal tract shown for section 20. The legal tract shown for section 20 should be switched with the legal tract shown for section 24. This correction will increase the total amount of acreage available for disposal by 0.95 acres. However, it will not change the methods available for disposal of any of these lands.

Map 15, Utility/Transportation Corridors and Communication Sites, shows utility corridor UC-2A passing through T. 16 1/2N., R. 20 1/2W., sec 24 in a North – South direction. This corridor existed in section 24 prior to the Lake Havasu Field Office (LHFO) RMP and thus verifies LHFO's intent to retain portions of section 24 to accommodate future utility right-of-ways in this corridor. Also the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) requested that the LHFO retain the lands identified in Map 14 section 24 for the possibility of realigning of Arizona Highway 95. ADOT's proposed project was identified in future transportation projects of the RMP.
