

## ARIZONA WILDERNESS ACT OF 1984

Public Law 98-406: Approved August 28, 1984. **Nine Wilderness areas managed by BLM**

- Title I Designated 30 Wilderness areas and required review of three wilderness study areas on the National Forests of the State of Arizona south of the Grand Canyon
- Title II Designated one area, Aravaipa Canyon Wilderness, approximately 6,670 acres, managed by the Bureau of Land Management
- Title III Sec. 301 (a) Designated eight Wilderness areas managed by the Arizona Strip District of the Bureau of Land Management
- (1) Cottonwood Point Wilderness – 6,500 acres
  - (2) Grand Wash Cliffs Wilderness – 36,300 acres
  - (3) Mount Logan Wilderness – 14,600 acres
  - (4) Mount Trumbull Wilderness – 7,900 acres
  - (5) Paiute Wilderness – 84,700 acres
  - (6) Paria Canyon-Vermilion Cliffs Wilderness – 110,000 acres, shared management with BLM in Utah
  - (7) Beaver Dam Mountains Wilderness – 19,600 acres, shared management with BLM in Utah
  - (8) Kanab Creek Wilderness – 77,100 acres, shared management with Kaibab National Forest
- Designated one Wilderness area managed by the Kaibab National Forest
- (9) Saddle Mountain Wilderness – 40,600 acres
