The Arizona Recreation Resource Advisory Council (RRAC) met on December 7, 2006 to review three recreation fee proposals from the U.S. Forest Service. This letter is to document the RRAC's action on each fee proposal for your review and notification to the appropriate Forest Service official.

Proposal: Timber Camp Campground, Tonto National Forest  
RRAC Action: Voted to support the fee proposal as presented and recommends approval.

Proposal: Groom Creek School/Cabin, Prescott National Forest  
RRAC Action: Voted to support the fee proposal as presented and recommends approval.

Proposal: Sycamore Cabin, Prescott National Forest  
RRAC Action: Voted to defer consideration of this proposal (1) until further evidence of public notification is accomplished per Section 4 of the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act, and (2) to enable additional opportunities for public involvement and support. Review status at the next RRAC meeting scheduled for March, 2007.
