

Dumont Dunes Annual Pass

1. Weekly passes with names and proof of purchase by the annual pass purchaser may be traded in towards credit for the annual pass.
2. There is dollar for dollar credit. This is to off-set a person not being able to purchase an annual pass at the beginning of the season.
3. There is a MAXIMUM of \$90 that can be applied to an annual pass purchase. That is because you can not purchase a holiday annual pass with the already purchased WEEKLY passes, unless you add \$30 in cash to the purchase to cover the holiday fee. (No one has paid for a holiday yet, as there has not been a holiday with the holiday fee yet.) Also, there are no refunds.
4. If someone is trading in a Thanksgiving \$40 pass for an annual pass, \$30 can count towards the base pass and \$10 towards the holiday extra fee. There should be very few Thanksgiving annual passes to trade in, and only those purchased at a vendor (not on-site) can be traded in. Officially the passes purchased prior to thanksgiving can be traded in and not those purchased for or after Thanksgiving. However, as some passes were sold in error, Rule 4 has been made to address those situations.
5. Only one pass for each week can be applied towards an annual pass. That is because if you had 2 passes for the same week, you entered with two primary vehicles, so you would have needed 2 annual passes if you were entering with annual passes.
6. ALL WEEKLY PASSES AND RECEIPTS TURNED IN TOWARDS ANNUAL PASSES BECOME THE PROPERTY OF BLM AND MUST BE GIVEN TO BLM.
7. BLM is providing the weekly pass trade in on-site at Dumont and through our office in Barstow, in person or through mail. Off-site vendors can not trade weekly passes for annual passes.
8. Turning in of weekly passes towards the purchase of an annual pass ends December 31, 1007.

Thanksgiving Weekly Passes are \$40. If a person purchased a pass for \$20, it was sold in error and is not valid. These passes may be turned in for a valid pass with an additional \$20.
