Twin Peaks Gather Inspection W

September 10, 2010 RR

This is a regularly scheduled facility inspection. Ten studs, 1 mule and one older burro, W six mares and three molly mules, one of which may be privately owned as she does not fit W the other two physically and has long hoof walls. One bay stud has sale authority brand W following the L neck freeze, and a cropped R ear, some have 'T' freeze brand left hip. W These are turnout animals that were transported here due to possible space issues with W holding facilities at gather. Private brands will be checked for on these animals all of W which are in good shape. They are going to food and water well. W

Checking the pair pen we found a bay mare with a large colt. The mare is visibly W depressed with her head down and lethargic. The wranglers will try and sort her off and W get her up to have a better look. There is an appaloosa mare with a new foal, probably W less than 24hrs old. Looks to be foaled this morning. We will try not to stir the pen up W and disrupt the new foal. All the other pens seem to be doing well, W

The branded gelding up front that had the L abdominal abscess seems to be doing well, W will continue to monitor. The mare with the RR laceration is doing well and will change W the bandage today. The foal that had the abscess on the pectoral region is doing well and W the mare is fine, will continue to monitor. The stud with the kick injury to the RF foreleg W is doing well and will change bandage today. W

The palomino foal which was found in an enclosure and the black foal that is orphaned W from the arab mare that was euthanized have been freeze branded and collared with W numbers 1424 and 1423 respectively. These two foals are doing well and may be placed W with a rehabilitation program for children. They are upfront by themselves and are eating W and drinking well. W
