

Suggested Tour Route

(Routes along suggested course are designated as open to all vehicles. 4WD needed.)

- Coming from US-98 turn North onto EC-274 near a Border Surveillance Tower.
- Take EC-274 to EC-308.
- Turn right on EC-308, and follow the road until you reach a large stone monument. *You are now at the Juan Bautista de Anza Overlook.*
- Go back down EC-308 to EC-274.
- Turn right on EC-274.
- Follow EC-274 until you reach an iron fence on your right. *You have now reached the Yuha Geoglyph.*
- Continue in the same direction on EC-274.
- At the intersection of EC-274 and EC-346 turn right onto EC-346.
- Follow EC-346 down into the wash. This road is lined with sandstone and hidden rocks. Drive with caution! *The fence line on your right will guide you to the Yuha Well.*

To exit the Yuha Desert:

- Continue to follow EC-346.
- EC-346 will merge with EC-274.
- Take EC-274 to Dunaway Road.

OR

- Retrace your path.
- Follow EC-346 west to EC-274.
- Turn left onto EC-274.
- Continue on EC-274 to US-98.

If you would like to continue to explore the Yuha Desert, you may want to contact the El Centro Field Office for a Western Colorado (WECO) Routes of Travel Map to help guide you through the area.

Please remember to stay on designated routes. Routes designated as limited are restricted to street legal vehicles only.
