



Attachment 1:
Conditions to NTP

1. Commercial operation and maintenance of turbines may only proceed after the turbines are connected to the Project's System Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system.
2. The BLM has reviewed the Operational Compliance Plans submitted by Holder and has provided an initial approval of those plans, subject to additional review. All components of the required Operational Compliance Plans must be fully implemented as submitted and/or modified by the BLM for any portion of the project under commercial operation.
3. Construction activities on any portion of the project site will continue to be subject to the requirements of the applicable Construction Compliance Plans until the conclusion of construction activities. The holder must seek concurrence from BLM that construction activities have been concluded and the applicable conditions have been met. All personnel working on the project site shall receive that applicable WEAP training while construction activities are ongoing.
4. Within 120 calendar days of completion of construction, the holder will submit to the Authorized Officer as-built drawings and a certification of construction verifying that the facility has been constructed in accordance with the design, plans, specifications, and applicable laws and regulations.
5. Prior to the conclusion of construction activities, the Applicant shall submit its long-term management plan for NRHP-eligible, CRHR-eligible sites or sites treated as eligible for project management purposes.
