



# Public Meeting Announcement

## For the Stateline Solar Farm Draft Environmental Impact Statement/ Environmental Impact Report



On November 23, 2012, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) published the Notice of Availability (NOA) for the Stateline Solar Farm Draft California Desert Conservation Area (CDCA) Plan Amendment and a Draft Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report (EIS/EIR). The Draft EIS/EIR analyzes the site-specific impacts of the Stateline Solar Farm Project on air quality, vegetation and wildlife, livestock grazing, cultural resources, water resources, recreation resources, wilderness characteristics, visual resources, and other resources and issues.

Desert Stateline, LLC requested authorization to construct, operate, maintain, and decommission the Stateline Solar Farm, a photovoltaic solar facility that could generate up to 300 megawatts of power with ancillary facilities including a generation interconnection (gen-tie) transmission line, site access road, and operations and maintenance facilities. The project would require approximately 2,143 acres of public lands. The proposed site is approximately 2 miles southwest of the community of Primm, Nevada, and approximately 0.5 miles to the west of Interstate-15.

Community participation is a critical part of the federal environmental review process. Publication of the NOA initiated a 90-day public comment period, which ends on February 21, 2013.

Three public meetings will be held to aid the public's understanding of this project and to solicit written comments on planning issues and the potential impacts, alternatives, and mitigation measures that should be considered in the Final EIS/EIR.


