

**CHEMEHUEVI MOUNTAINS WILDERNESS**  
**84,056 Acres**  
**Designated October 31, 1994 by the California Desert Protection Act,**  
**Public Law 103-433**

This is the final legal description as required in Section 103(b) of the above mentioned Act. It describes the boundary for the Chemehuevi Mountains Wilderness Area located in San Bernardino County, California and managed by the Bureau of Land Management. The boundary is more particularly described as follows:

From the corner of sections 3 and 4, T.5 N., R.24E., SBM, this point also being on the Chemehuevi Indian Reservation boundary, said point being the point of beginning;

thence southerly along the section line between sections 3 and 4, coincident with the Chemehuevi Indian Reservation boundary, to point 1, the corner of sections 3, 4, 9, and 10;

thence southerly along the section line between sections 9 and 10, 15 and 16, 21 and 22, 27 and 28, 33 and 34, coincident with the Chemehuevi Indian Reservation boundary, to point 2, the township line at the corner of sections 33 and 34, T.5N., R.24E., SBM;

thence southerly on the prolongation of the line between sections 33 and 34, leaving the Chemehuevi Indian Reservation boundary, to point 3, the intersection of a line 300 ft. northerly of and parallel with the centerline of Havasu Lake Road;

thence westerly along a line parallel with, and 300 feet north of said centerline to point 4, the intersection of the eastern section line of section 36, T.5N., R.23E., SBM;

thence northerly along said section line to point 5, the closing corner of Ts.4 ½ and 5N., R.24E., SBM;

thence northerly along the range line between sections 31 and 36 to point 6, the corner of sections 25 and 36 only, T.5N., R.23E., SBM;

thence westerly along the section line between sections 25 and 36 to point 7, the corner of sections 25, 26, 35 and 36;

thence southerly along the section line between sections 35 and 36 to point 8, the northernmost edge of the right-of-way LA 052062 for the Metropolitan Water District electrical transmission line and road;

thence northwesterly along the northernmost edge of said right-of-way to point 9, a point 30 feet east of the centerline of an unimproved northwesterly bearing dirt road near the Sawtooth Range;

thence northerly along a line parallel with and 30 feet easterly of the centerline of said dirt road to point 10, the intersection of the range line between sections 7 and 12, T.5N., Rgs.22 and 23E., SBM;

thence northerly along said range line between sections 7 and 12 to point 11, the corner of sections 1, 6, 7, and 12;

thence northerly along the range line between sections 1 and 6 to point 12, the township corner of T. 5 N., Rs. 22 and 23 E., SBM;

thence westerly along the township line between sections 31 and 1 to point 13, the township corner of, T.6N., Rgs.22 and 23E., SBM;

thence northerly along the range line between sections 31 and 36, T. 6 N., Rgs. 22 and 23 E., SBM, to point 14, the corner of sections 25, 30, 31 and 36;

thence northerly along the range line between sections 25 and 30 to point 15, the corner of sections 19, 24, 25 and 30;

thence westerly along the section line between sections 24 and 25 to point 16, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet easterly of the centerline of a northwesterly bearing unimproved dirt road through the Sawtooth Range;

thence northwesterly along a line parallel with and 30 feet easterly of centerline of said unimproved dirt road to point 17, the intersection of a line parallel with and 300 feet easterly of the centerline of Hwy 95;

thence northerly along a line parallel with and 300 feet easterly of the centerline of Hwy. 95 to point 18, a point along the southern edge of gas pipeline right-of-way LA 0118349 in section 19, T.7N., R.23E., SBM;

thence northeasterly along the southern edge of said gas pipeline right-of-way or 30 feet offset from the centerline of the maintenance road, whichever is farther south, to point 19, the intersection of the section line between sections 7 and 8, T.7N., R.24E., and the intersection of the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary;

thence southerly along the section line between sections 7 and 8 and coincident with the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary, to point 20, the corner of sections 7, 8, 17, and 18;

thence easterly along the section line between sections 8 and 17 and coincident with the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary, to point 21, the corner of sections 8, 9, 16, and 17;

thence southerly, leaving the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary, along the section line between sections 16 and 17 to point 22, the corner of sections 16, 17, 20 and 21;

thence easterly along the section line between sections 16 and 21 to point 23, the corner of sections 15, 16, 21 and 22 and the intersection of the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary;

thence southerly along the section line between sections 21 and 22, 27 and 28, 33 and 34, coincident with the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge, to point 24, the corner of sections 33, 34, 3, and 4 on the township line between, Ts.6 and 7N., R.24E., SBM;

thence southerly along the section lines between sections 3 and 4, T. 6 N., R. 24 E., and coincident with the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary, to point 25, the 1/4 section corner between sections 3 and 4;

thence easterly coincident with the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary, to point 26, the center 1/4 section corner of section 3;

thence southerly along the north-south centerline of sections 3, 10, and 15, coincident with the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary, to point 27, the center 1/4 section corner of section 15;

thence easterly along the east-west centerline of section 15, coincident with the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary, to point 28, the 1/4 section corner between sections 14 and 15;

thence southerly along the line between sections 14 and 15, and 22 and 23, coincident with the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary, to point 29, the corner of sections 22, 23, 26, and 27, said point also being the intersection of the Chemehuevi Indian Reservation boundary;

thence southerly, leaving the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge boundary, along the line between sections 26 and 27, and 34 and 36, coincident with the Chemehuevi Indian Reservation boundary to point 30, the corner of sections 34 and 35 only, on the township line of Ts. 5 and 6 N., R. 24 E.;


thence westerly on the township line between sections 34 and 3 to the point of beginning.


***End of Description***

The above description containing approximately 84,056 acres utilizes the Castle Rock, Chemehuevi Peak, Havasu Lake, Monumental Pass, Savahia Peak Northeast, Snaggletooth, Toprock, and Whale Mountain 7.5 minute quadrangle maps prepared by the USGS. The boundary calls listed herein are a result in part of scaling distances from said quad maps and are not a result of survey. All courses have been depicted upon the above mentioned quad maps and are made part of this official record. Acreage is calculated from the California BLM State Office Arc/Info wilderness coverage.

I hereby certify the legal description and map herewith represent the location of the boundary of the Chemehuevi Mountains Wilderness designated by the California Desert Protection Act, Public Law 103-433, dated October 31, 1994.
